
Orientation for BRAC University MBA students

Mohasthorir's killing Bouddha Sangha submits memo to President

The Bangladesh Bouddha Krishi Prachar Sangha submitted a memorandum to President AQM Badruddoza Chowdhury yesterday demanding exemplary punishment to the killers of Ganojoti Mohasthorir, a Buddhist monk.

Mohasthorir, 52, was slain by a gang of assailants at a temple in Hingala village under Raozan thana in Chittagong in the early hours of Monday.

A six-member delegation of the Sangha, led by its president Shuddhanando Mohathero, met the President at Bangabhaban and

discussed various problems facing the Buddhists in various parts of the country.

Later, in a press statement, the Sangha strongly condemned and protested the killing incident.

They demanded immediate arrest and trial of the killers. They also made a call to the civil society to raise voice against such heinous crime.

Meanwhile, Food Minister Abdullah Al Noman condemned the killing of Ganojoti Mohasthorir and directed the authorities concerned to nab the culprits.

AL leaders to visit Jamal's home at Kapasia

Central leaders of Awami League will visit Kapasia in Gazipur on April 27 to console the family of Jamaluddin Fakir allegedly tortured to death at the police station.

A team of AL leaders led by its acting president Abdus Samad Azad will visit the victim's home, meet with his family members and offer prayers at his grave.

They will also hold a rally there to protest the killing of Jamal, whose body was recovered from river Shitalakhya on Saturday.

Plea not to close down ETV

Urgent Notice for Bonded Warehouse Licence Users

It is notified for kind information of all kinds of bonded warehouse licence users in Bangladesh that, with a view to expediting clearance of goods এসিকিউড ++ computer programme will be introduced soon at different customs station/house in the country. To clear imported goods for bonded warehouse through এসিকিউড ++, the bonded warehouse licence users shall have to use a licence number to be issued by Customs Bond Commissioner. Arrangement has been made to issue this serial licence number using computer programme at Bond Commissionerate.

For this, the respective bonders are requested to collect the form issued by CAM-1 from their respective association and after properly filling in, deposit to the association by 30-4-2002. Respective associations are also requested to verify the filled in bonds and reach them to the Bond Commissionerate by 05-05-2002.
