Water Supply Project not yet completed

The people of Sylhet town have long been suffering from water crisis as the Sylhet Water Supply Project could not be completed even two years after the scheduled

Though a handful number of well-off people had sunk deep tubewells for collecting water, most of the people are still dependent on the shallow tubewells and the existing water supply system of pourasava, which cannot meet the demand of the towndwellers.

indigenous system to supply water the river Surma. through its age-old deep tubewells. It has a capacity of only 16.48 lakh gallons of water whereas the total demand of the town-dwellers now stands at 82,44 lakh gallons.

erative in many areas. The water crisis takes a serious turn during the winter season every year as the shallow tubewells do not work properly at that time. People of Shahjalal Upashahar, Baluchar and Shibganj suffer most during the period.

Earlier, ponds and wells were being used as source of water, but most of those have been filled up, worsening the situation.

The only water treatment plant in Sylhet town, installed in 1918, is in a very bad shape. With a capacity of supply 3.9 lakh gallons of water, the plant is still being used Pourashava authority has an for treating water collected from

Some people alleged that although the age-old water treatment plant was declared abandoned years ago, it is being used for reasons unknown. It is not possible to make the old plant usable even after major repair work, they added.

To ease the water crisis, the pourashava authority sank nine deep tubewells and expanded its supply network up to another 61 kilometres. Yet there is a great demand for expansion of the water supply network.

On the other hand, it has been found that, out of over 5000 subscribers, only 700 pay the water supply charges to the pourashava authority regularly. The arrears now stands at Tk one crore and four lakh, sources said.

Sylhet Pourashava chairman Badar Uddin Kamran said, "We are hopeful of completing the project by the end of this fiscal year. We suffered a lot of hassles while selecting the sites for a number of deep tubewells. And there are still some more problems we had to overcome to complete the Sylhet Water Supply Project.

Executive Engineer of the Department of Public Health Engineering, however, said only 60 per cent of the town-dwellers' demand would be met once the project is completed.

According to some reliable sources, construction of a water tank under the nine-town project had been remained suspended for long and laying of pipelines in many areas could not be com-

Water Supply Project" was taken up in 1995 under an ADB-aided programme for 9 district headquarters pourashavas of the country and it was scheduled to be completed by 2000.

Every child dreams about a bright future. But there are many stories to tell when a child like Shaheen Ara says, "I want to be educated to end the miseries of life."

Shaheen Ara is a domestic help in Panchlaish area of Chittagong district. She doesn't like her job at all because her employers beat her almost every day. "They even beat me if I don't play with their child,' she said with her eyes tearing.

For children like Shaheen Ara, the Basic Education for Hard To Reach (HTR) Urban Children Programme comes as a source of respite, freedom and inspiration.

Now her most favourite time of the day is when she attends the classes of HTR at Sundabipara centre at Panchlaish. Samaj Unnavan Kendra (SUK), a nongovernment organisation, runs this centre, which is one of the hundreds being implemented under a government scheme. Education Ministry took up the

project in 1998 with the financial support from UNICEF, Government of Sweden and DFID. The project was designed to meet the educational needs of the working children. The government is executing the programme through different non-government organisations in six urban areas.

Nearly 56pc support PM's proposal on portraits: Survey

About 55.92 per cent people of the country have supported Prime Minister Khaleda Zia's proposal to display the portraits of two na-Sheikh Mujibur Rahman and Ziaur Rahman -- and the incumbent prime minister in government offices and Bangladesh missions abroad, according to a recent sur-

Khaleda made the proposal in her winding-up speech in the last session of the Jatiya Sangsad on April 10.

The survey was conducted by the Bangladesh Sangbad Sangstha in four divisional headquarters of Dhaka, Chittagong, Rajshahi and

The survey was conducted on random sampling where majority of people welcomed the PM's proposal as a move to dispel the controversy between the two main contending political parties -- the ruling Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP) and the opposition Awami League.

The past Awami League government had made it obligatory by passing a law in Parliament to display the portrait of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman in all government, semigovernment and autonomous offices and Bangladesh missions

About 62.5 per cent of respondents in Dhaka city said the proposal of Prime Minister Khaleda Zia was a moderate political approach to the issue and it would have no impact on the current political scenario if reciprocated by the other side.

In Chittagong, about 52.4 per cent respondents approved of the proposal. But 38.6 per cent expressed their doubt whether this will end the current impasse between the two main political par-

In Rajshahi, about 60 per cent of the respondents termed the proposal constructive and 58.62 per cent observed that the proposal would help defuse the tension created centring the debate on displaying the portrait of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rah-

The 48.9 per cent respondents of Khulna city expressed their support to the proposal of Khaleda Zia while 35 per cent observed that only the portrait of head of the government should be displayed in the offices.




