Shihab murder Next hearing tomorrow

The Second Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judge's Court, Dhaka Monday fixed May 2 for appearance of the accused in connection with the abduction and killing of schoolboy Khandaker Shihab Ahmed.

Judge Hossain Shahid Ahmed passed the order after the documents of the case were placed before the court for fixing date for its next hearing.

The CMM's Court, Dhaka on Sunday sent the case to the

Judge's Court for trial. Detective Branch (DB) Inspector Nazrul Islam, Investigation Officer of the case submitted a chargesheet to the CMM's Court on April 18 against six people. Of the accused, Monir Hossain Liton and Abu Syed were arrested. The four others have been absconding since the incident.

Shihab, 13, a student of class seven of Motijheel Model High School, was abducted from in front of his school on February 7. Later, he was killed as he allegedly recognised one of the abductors.

Victim's father Khondaker Dilder Ahmed filed a General Diary (GD) with Motijheel Thana on February 7 after his son was missing. Later, it was turned into a regular case on February 10.

Shahriar Kabir was arrested at Zia International Airport on November 22 last year, on his return from Kolkata.

Police also seized his passport and some video cassettes.

Later, a sedition case against Shahriar Kabir was filed with the CMM's Court, Dhaka on December 8 last year.

The Appellate Division of the Supreme Court Monday stayed till May 12 the hearing of the writ petitions filed in the High Court Division by officers sent on compulsory retirement by the gov-

A bench of the Appellate Division comprising Chief Justice Mahmudul Amin Choudhury, Justice Mohammad Ruhul Amin appeal before this date. and Justice K M Hasan passed the order upon hearing a petition filed by the government.

Some government officers were sent on compulsory retirement under section 9 of Public Service Retirement Act as they completed 25 years of service.

These officers filed writ petitions before the High Court Division challenging the legality of

their compulsory retirement. The hearing of 36 writ petitions started in a HC Division bench comprising Justice Mohammad Hamidul Haque and Justice Nazmun Ara Sultana last week.

On the second day of the hearing, the government submit-

ted that the petitions were not filed in the proper court, but the High Court Division passed an

order and rejected the submission. The government filed a civil miscellaneous petition before the Appellate Division challenging the

High Court order. After hearing the petition, the Appellate Division stayed the hearing till May 12 and directed the government to file leave to
