Improve public health for economic dev

Experts tell workshop in city

BSS, Dhaka

Experts and senior government officials yesterday laid emphasis on improving public health to achieve economic development of the least developed countries like Bangladesh.

Poor health of the people is a major impediment for economic growth and development while healthy population is the prerequisite for national development, they said.

They were speaking at a "Dissemination Workshop on the Report of the Commission on Macroeconomics of Health and Role of Health, Nutrition and Population Sector in Poverty Reduction Strategy Paper (PRSP)" at BIAM auditorium here.

Principal and Cabinet Secretary Dr Kamal Uddin Siddique inaugurated the workshop as chief guest while Health Secretary M Fazlur Rahman was in the chair.

ERD secretary Anisul Huq Chowdhury, education secretary M Shahidul Alam, secretary of planning division Badir Rahman, finance secretary Zakir Ahmed Khan, WHO representative to Bangladesh Dr Sunithi Acharya and head of DFID Paul Ackroyd attended the inaugural function.

Speaking on the occasion, they laid emphasis on increasing budgetary allocation to the health sector and strengthening interaction for getting donor support to address the health challenges in the low-income countries.

Terming health as the principal engine of development, Dr Kamal Siddique said sound health is a

pre-condition for economic growth and development. "The health sector can improve the economic condition of the people of the country," he added.

Dr Sergio Spinaci, executive secretary of the World Health Organisation presented the report published recently by the Commission on Macroeconomics and Health (CMH) to assess the place health in global economic development.

Giving the salient features of the global health situation, the report said the minimum financing need is 30 to 40 US dollars per person per year. But the current actual spending in the least developed countries is only 13 US dollars.

"Timely and bold actions can save at least eight million lives each year by the end of this decade, extending the life spans, productivity and economic well-being of the poor," it added.

1204 more held

BSS, Dhaka

Police arrested 1,204 people including two "listed terrorists" from across the country and seized three firearms and a lethal weapon along with 13 bullets during 24 hours ending at 6 yesterday morning.

Of them, 685 were arrested under warrant, 513 were nabbed in connection with cases under investigation.

Police arrested four persons with arms and lodged three cases under Arms Act in this connection.
