A head-on collision between a car and a bus left four members of a family and the driver of the car killed on Dhaka-Bogra Highway in

Sherpur on Monday noon. Among those killed are Shali, 30, Iqbal, 28, Anna, 12, and Shaheb Ali, 28, driver of the car.

The Dhaka-bound car (Dhaka-Metro-Gha-14-5105) and the Rajshahi-bound bus of Mahi Enterprise (Raj-Metro-Bha-11-0012) collided head-on at Ghoga Battala in the district, police said. The collision left five persons killed on the spot and damaged the car beyond repair.

The locals rescued an 11-yearold boy and a 13-year-old girl. But the boy died on the way to the Mohammad Ali Hospital in Bogra. The on-duty doctor said the

girl was shifted to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital, as her condition was serious. In another accident, Liaquat

Ali, 40, a security guard, died instantly when a Dhaka-bound truck slammed into another parked truck.


