City corpn polls Candidates asked to submit return by tomorrow

BSS, Dhaka The Election Commission yesterday reminded the all candidates in the elections to three city corporations to submit their return of election expenses by tomorrow.

The Commission in a handout said in line with the election laws all candidates must submit their return in the prescribed Form-D in 15 days of gazette notification of the election results.

Under the relevant law a copy of the return and affidavit have to be sent to the Election Commission by post while the original one is submitted to the concerned returning officer.

The handout said the candidates were already been informed about the matter.

The commission warned that the failure to submit the return within the stipulated time frame would be treated as a "punishable offense" according to the election laws under which one might face seven years of rigorous imprisonment in addition to fines.


