# No case filed yet

Even after two days, no case was filed in connection with the killing of Siddhartha Sarkar, general secretary of the Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), Tejgaon College

Siddhartha was shot dead by unidentified armed men in Badda area while he was returning by a microbus after attending a Chhatra League conference there on Sunday night.

Badda police said that nobody appeared in the thana to file any case in this connection.

The police, however, said they will file a case soon.

The BCL leader was reported to have killed when the miscreants try towards anarchy through kill-

He contracted his cab for TI 100 for a ride from Farmgate to Rampura, while the yellow car's meter read only half the amount.

The driver defended the rate saying he had nothing to do as he has to pay his owner Tk 900 everyday. According to the driver, both passengers and the drivers became "hostage" in the hands of the cab owners.

A cab of Salida charged Tk 200 for a ride from Panthapath to Gandaria in the evening, while another one of Cabex charged Tk 500 for Narayanganj from Greenroad at dead hours of night.

Operating companies import cabs availing of the duty waiver and then sell out those on "hirepurchase" agreement to individual buyers. The Company only gives the radio link service and has no supervision on the overall cab service.

The owners keep the cabs in their custody, and operate those by appointed drivers or just rent out those at daily rates ranging from Tk 800 to Tk 900.




