1. The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received a credit from the International Development Association (IDA), towards the cost of the project on Post-Literacy and Continuing Education for Human Development and intends to apply part of the proceeds of this credit to payments under the contract for NGO services for monitoring, evaluation & technical supervision of Post-Literacy and Continuing Education Program.

The Directorate of Non-Formal Education invites proposals from the eligible NGOs for services required for monitoring, evaluation and technical supervision of Post-Literacy and Continuing Education Program in 230 upazilas for the entire project period (42 months during FY 2002-03 to FY 2005-06). Approximately, 30 centers would be established in each upazila. (List of upazila attached). The Program Implementation NGOs (PI-NGOs) will not be eligible for Program Monitoring NGOs (PM-NGOs) under this program in the same upazila and vice-versa.

2. Each upazila will comprise one package (unit) covering approximately thirty Post-Literacy and Continuing Education Centers. Interested NGOs may submit proposal for one or more units. The eligibility & selection criteria for NGOs are as follows:

3. **Eligible Criteria:** Applicants should meet the following eligibility criteria:

- (1) Be registered with the Social Welfare Department/Directorate of Women Affairs/Bureau of NGO Affairs/Registrar of Joint Stock Companies of the government.
- (2) Have at least 3 years experience prior to the date of submitting proposal;
- (3) Be a non-profit and non-political organization;
- (4) Have a duly approved constitution as per relevant registration Act;
- (5) Have properly constituted managing body with clearly defined rules and responsibilities of all the members of the Management Committee and office bearers;
- (6) Have established/registered office premises with postal and location address;
- (7) Have established office premises either in the locality where the NGOs proposes to work or in the capital city (Dhaka);
- (8) Have at least two years experience in the field of NFE;
- (9) Have experience in basic literacy program and be willing to work in one or more of the selected upazilas;
- (10) Not to seek or receive fund from more than one source for the same program in the same area;
- (11) Have trained managerial and technical personnel for NFE;
- (12) Have ability/provision to bear a part of overhead cost (maintenance of office/salaries/wages of management personnel, etc.) from its own resources, and provide bank solvency certificate to that effect;
- (13) Have a good system of maintaining accounts and audit report for the last financial year or the calendar year;
- (14) Have some experience in program for women or children in any form.
