The government has already formed "Forests Management Unit" in this regard, Forests and Environment Minister Shahjahan Siraj stated this while talking to agement system. BSS here yesterday.

Shahjahan Siraj said in the first phase of the project decision has been taken to recover forest lands Dhaka, Tangail and Mymensingh areas from illegal occupants. The project cost in the areas has been estimated at Tk 820.64 crore.

Some 38,691.34 hectares out of nearly 10.04 lakh of total forest areas under Dhaka, Tangail and Mymensingh districts are occupied by some 36.945 illegal occu-

Of the total, 25,506 hectares of forest land out of 49,747.73 hectares remained occupied only in Tangail district, 9,465.74 hectares out of 28485.83 hectares in Mymensingh district and 3,719.60 hectares out of 26,220.71 hectares in Dhaka district have been illegally occupied.
