South Korea has eased visa requirements for Chinese football fans travelling to the country to cheer on their team in its first World Cup, tournament organisers said

Chinese holding World Cup tickets bearing their names, and who have visited Korea before, can receive a visa simply by submitting a copy of their tickets, the Korean Organizing Committee for the World Cup said in a statement.

Ticket holders who have not visited South Korea before are required to present a financial document proving a bank deposit of more than 10,000 US dollars as well as a copy of their ticket.

Chinese fans invited by 15 official sponsors associated with football's governing body FIFA or six local suppliers can receive visas by handing in invitation letters, their

employment certificate, and ticket Even if the letter is not available,

statement added. There are other rules for those invited by companies other than FIFA partners or local "With eased visa requirements, Chinese fans can expect easy and

speedy entrance," the statement

Fans coming to Korea on package tours provided by designated travel agencies do not need to present ticket copies.

Estimates of the number of Chinese expected in South Korea to support their country in first round games against Brazil, Costa Rica and Turkey range as high as 100,000, although figures are hard to gauge as many are thought to be buying tickets through unofficial sources.

Chinese people have in the past vanished inside South Korea or used the country as a transit point to smuggle into other developed
