Shipu Murder Defence to go to higher court, seek transfer of case

The Third Additional Metropolitan Sessions Judge's Court, Dhaka yesterday adjourned the hearing of the Shipu Murder Case.

Judge Molla Mostafa Kamal adjourned the hearing till May 30 following a time petition by the defence lawyers.

Moving the petition Advocate Syed Shamim Ahsan Habib stated that Additional Metropolitan PP Golam Mostafa Khan obstructed him (Shamim) to cross-examine the 4th prosecution witness Rezaul Karim in a legal process. Moreover, the learned judge himself directed him (Shamim) to be careful to ask questions to the witness. He felt apprehension to get justice from the court. As a result, he (lawyer) was not desirable to conduct the case in such court and he would go to the higher court to seek transfer of the

case to another court.

The prosecution side opposed the petition.

After hearing both the sides, the court granted the petition.

In its order, the court mentioned that the matter of asking questions to the witness carefully was not correct and it is the first duty to try a case neutrally as a judge. Moreover, the defence lawyer made such submission as he (lawyer) was restrained from asking unnecessary questions to the witness. So, the petition seeking adjournment of the hearing, is granted as the defence lawyer submitted the petition on behalf of the accused -- Joy Hasib, Kazi Arif Ahmed Sagar and Kazi Sharif Ahmed Saikat -- to go to the higher court to transfer the case from the trial court.

Earlier, three prosecution witnesses, including complainant of the case were cross-examined. Accused Kazi Sharif Ahmed Saikat and Joy Hasib, now detained in the Dhaka Central Jail,

were produced before the court during the hearing. Kazi Arif Ahmed Sagar, now on bail, was also present in the court.

Three other accused -- Ziauddin Ahmed Jewel, son of former Awami League lawmaker Kamal Ahmed Majumder, Naimuzzaman Zohayer and Shafiq Alam have been absconding since the incident.

Itekhkar Ahmed Shipu, a mobile phone trader at UAE Moitree Market in the city's Banani area, was shot dead on May 24, 2000.

Victim's brother Istiaqul Ahmed filed a case with Gulshan thana accusing six people, including Jewel, the following day.

CU Dean election on May 30

Election to the Dean of Commerce Faculty of Chittagong University (CU) will be held on May 30.

The contesting teachers are: Dr. Ashraf Ali of management department (Left-leaning pink panel), Shanti Ranjan Das of accounting department (AL-backed blue panel), Dr. ANM Muktar of finance department (BNP-backed white panel) and Dr. Harun-ur-Rashid, also of finance department (Jamaat-backed panel).

Sources said teachers belonging to 'White Panel' backed by ruling BNP-Jamaat coalition have split over the dean election.

Pro-BNP teachers have expressed their regret over the split and blamed the pro-Jamaat teachers for not supporting their candidate.

They said the Jamaat-leaning teachers have already established their supremacy in all the councils of the university with the support of pro-BNP teachers.

But despite that the pro-Jamaat teachers have put up their own candidate in the dean election against the white panel.

This has angered the pro-BNP teachers of CU and they are now very much annoyed with Jamaat-leaning teachers for their 'betrayal', the sources added.
