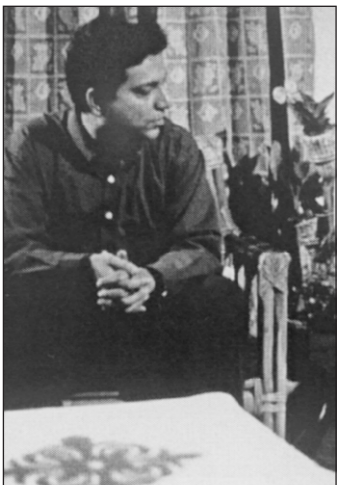
## Satellite TV

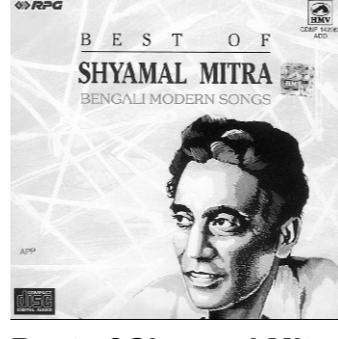
**Ustad Amjad Ali Khan**

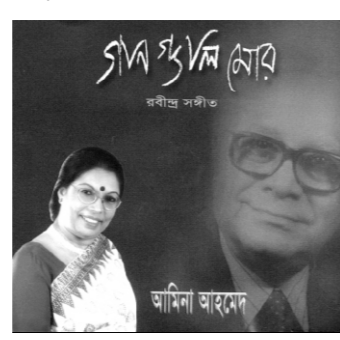
**Maestro's Choice**

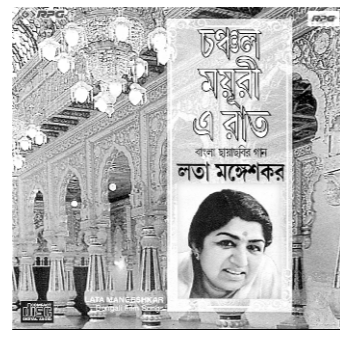
**Best of Shyamal Mitra**

King of Bengali melody Shyamal Mitra needs no introduction. His soothing and romantic voice has been cherished millions for over forty years now.



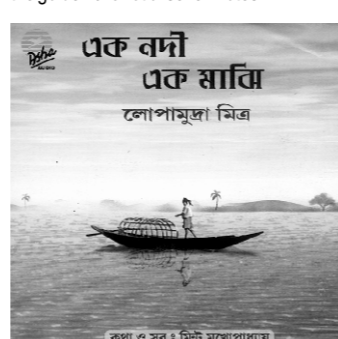
**S.D. Burman: The Inimitable Composer**

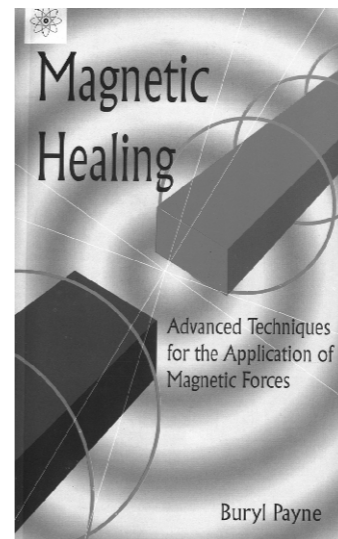


**Ayurvedic Healing**

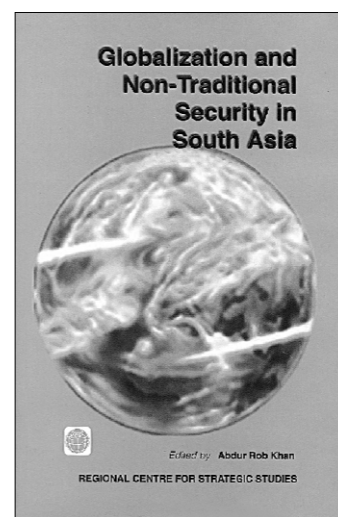


**Stress-free Work with Yoga and Ayurveda**

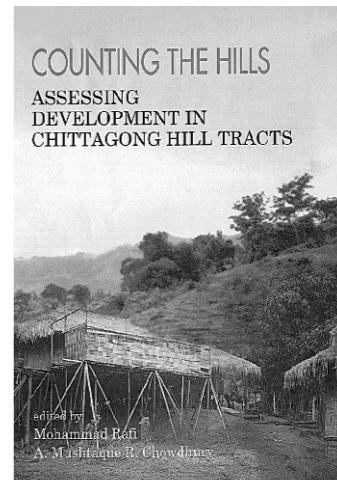


**Magnetic Healing**

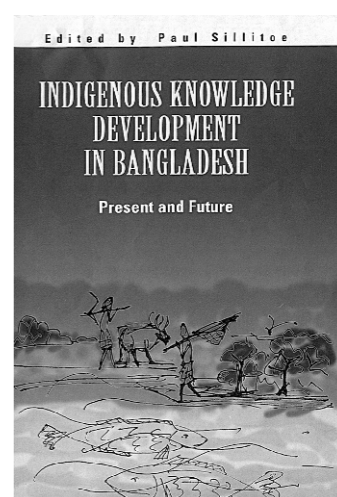


**Globalization and Non-Traditional Security in South Asia**

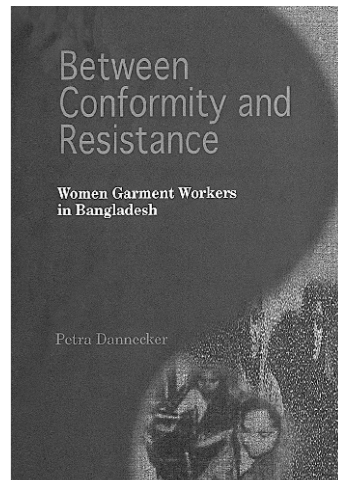


**Indigenous Knowledge Development in Bangladesh**

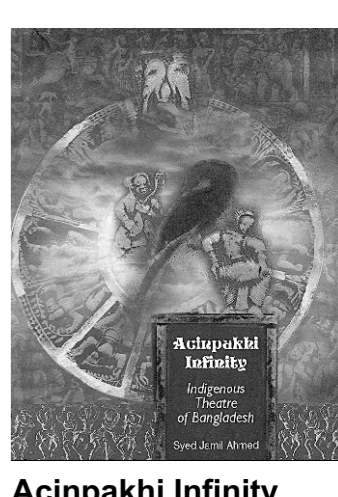

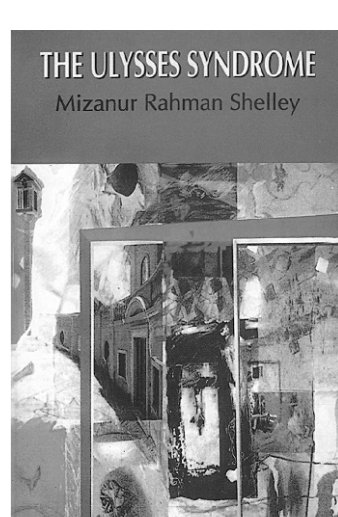

This book contributes to the ongoing discussions and discourses about processes of economic globalization and the so-called feminization of labour that accompany the economic and social transformations taking place world-wide. The focus is on the new modes of industrial production, notably in the export-oriented manufacturing sector in Bangladesh, where there is an increased participation of women in the workforce. The book intends to show the Bangladeshi women workers view themselves and their actions within the given cultural, political and economic setting. Their migration pattern and motives and the recruitment strategies, from the point of the employers as well as the workers are analyzed.



**Acinpakhi Infinity**  
Indigenous Theatre of Bangladesh  
Syed Jamil Ahmed, Price: Tk 900.00  
Acinpakhi Infinity combines a wide range of theoretical learning and understanding of the indigenous theatre in Bangladesh and describes fully the way in which the tradition lives in Bangladesh today. It studies over eighty genres, which are related to various religions, (such as Islam and Buddhism), and cults (such as Krsna and Caitanya, Ramacandra, Siva and Kali, Manasa and Natha). It also includes a number of secular performances. The methodology adopted for major part of the study is based on fieldwork which includes witnessing performances in actual condition, interviewing the performers and the spectators, and studying written texts, audio recording and photographs of performances. In a few cases, performances, which no longer exist, have also been studied from published accounts.



**The Ulysses Syndrome**

This book is about people and places. Varied and memorable experiences of encounters with diverse nations and nationals find their place in this work. This is the chronicle of people and events in different lands, far and near, but more than a traveller's journal. It relates and analyzes author's experiences in many countries including Bangladesh, the USA, the UK, Germany, the erstwhile Soviet Union, Austria, Jamaica, Thailand and Saudi Arabia.
