Rain likely
Light to moderate rain or thundershowers accompanied by temporary gusty or squally wind is likely at a few places over Dhaka, Chittagong, Barisal and Sylhet Divisions and one or two places over Rajshahi and Khulna divisions during the next 12 hours till 6 pm today. Southwestern monsoon is advancing to Teknaf coast, which is likely to sweep over Chittagong division in next 72 hours. Met office said, adding that day temperature may remain nearly unchanged over the country.

One stabbed to death in city

Unidentified miscreants stabbed a young man to death at Hazaribagh in old part of the city on Thursday night.

The identity of the victim aged about 30 could not be known. Police recovered the body from near the Lather Technology Institute at about 2:00 pm yesterday and sent it to Dhaka Medical College Hospital for autopsy.

Police said that miscreant picked up the man on Thursday night and stabbed him to death.

A murder case was filed with the Lalbagh Police Station in this connection.

Zia Museum stands as silent witness to past glory

Museum, the showcase of heritage of a nation, and a unique bridge between the past and present, particularly link up the glorious past through different evidences, antiques and documents to the living people and posterity.

But Zia Memorial Museum (ZMM) in Chittagong is one with a difference which simultaneously carrying the symbol of national glory involving a great freedom fighter, late president Ziaur Rahman, who proclaimed independence of the country from Kalurghat Radio Station.

This museum is drawing hundreds of visitors daily - men, women and children - who see in it the glorious past of a nation and works of Shaheed Zia.

"It is not merely a visit to a museum, it is my love, respect and admiration for Zia that brings me here again and again," said elderly Rezia Khatun. She came to the museum with her grandson and other relatives.

The Chittagong Circuit House, one of the unique architectural

installations of the British regime, was built in 1913 and it was converted into a museum on September 6, 1993 in commemoration of President Ziaur Rahman who was killed by a group of disgruntled army men at the circuit house on May 30, 1981.

This is a unit of Bangladesh National Museum under the Ministry of Cultural Affairs having 12 galleries, a full-fledged auditorium with a capacity of 160 seats, a library on Liberation War and Offices. The museum is located at the heart of the port city.

The museum displays historic microphone and transmitter of Kalurghat Radio Station through which Zia proclaimed Liberation War in 1971, personal dresses, an ordinary suitcase, holy quran, jainamaj, cap, shaving brush used by Zia, handwritings, simple menu of his diet, photographs of the seven Bir Srestha, blood stained carpet, and marks of bullets.

"On an average, 750 people visit the museum daily on weekdays while on holidays, the number of visitors increases to

around one thousand.

A total of 11,650 people visited the museum in April last," said Mohammad Sultan Mahmud, administrative-cum-security officer of the ZMM.

The museum is apparently well maintained in terms of security system, preservation of antiques and documents. However, some problems are emerging slowly which, in future, could take a serious turn if the authority does not resolve them timely, a source in the ZMM said.

One of the problems was that no major renovation work was done in the nearly century-old building.

Sources in the Public Works Departments (PWD) said that a project proposal at an estimated cost of Tk 7 lakh for the development and renovation of the museum is under consideration.

"I am delighted to see the museum but there is a scope to include more objects," said Thungy Marma, who came to visit the museum with his spouse from Khagrachari district.
