

## BSF returns 5 Bangladeshis

BSS, Rajshahi

Indian Border Security Force (BSF) yesterday handed over five Bangladeshis to the BDR at a flag meeting at 'No Man's Land' near Alaipur under Bagha upazila here.

Five persons, who were arrested by the members of Indian Border Security Force (BSF) on Sunday were identified as Nimai Chandra Das, 58, Bashanti Rani

Das, 50, Ria Rani Das, 40, Manik Kumar Das, 18, and Bulu Rani Das, 14. All of them belong to one family of Arani village under Bagha upazila.

According to the BDR source, they entered the Indian territory illegally and were arrested by the BSF men on Sunday last.

The flag meeting was held at the Company Commander level, BDR sources said.

## Biman incurs a loss of Tk 98.25cr

State Minister for Civil Aviation and Tourism Mir Mohammad Nasiruddin yesterday said Bangladesh Biman's total loss would stand at Tk 98.25 crore as per the revised budget of the current fiscal year.

He said this while replying to a written question of Delwar Hos-

sain Saidee of Jamaat in the Jatiya Sangsad. He mentioned post-September 11 global situation as the cause of this loss, which resulted in an unexpected fall in the number of passengers, rise in insurance premium and fuel price hike.

Replying to another question from Mohammad Ali Jinnah of BNP, the state minister said various travel agencies, mostly abroad, owe Tk 28.25 crore to Biman Bangladesh. "We have already taken legal action against these travel agencies".

Nasiruddin said the government had already cancelled licences of 156 travel agencies for

their failure to pay off the dues.

Replying to another supplementary, he said the Civil Aviation authorities had undertaken various steps including auto-cancellation system and issuance of refusal letter to raise the number of passengers for Biman flights.

The state minister said the Biman fleet include a total 15 aircraft -- three F-28, four airbuses and six DC-10-30s. Besides, two ATP aircraft have been grounded for sale.

The government is planning to raise the number of small aircraft on the domestic routes, he said.

## Bangladesh peacekeepers in 10 countries

BSS, Dhaka

As many as 417 officials, 228 Junior Commissioned Officers (JCOs) and 4,618 jawans of Bangladesh Army are now engaged in UN peace missions in 10 countries of the world.

This was disclosed by State Minister for Liberation War Affairs Redwan Ahmed in the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday while replying to a question from Md Giasuddin of BNP from Narayanganj. He gave the reply in absence of Defence Minister-in-Charge Hafiz Uddin Ahmed, Bir Bikram.

The countries where members of the Bangladesh Army are engaged in UN peace keeping are East Timor, West Africa, Kuwait, Iraq, Sierra Leone, Congo, Eritria and Ethiopia, Croatia, Georgia and Kosovo.

To supplementaries, Redwan Ahmed said that a total of 21 army men were killed and 37 others injured so far while they were on duty in peace keeping missions in different countries. "Members of the families of these victims get compensation from the government," he said.

He also said that the government, on receiving UN proposal for sending troops to any particular country for peacekeeping pur-

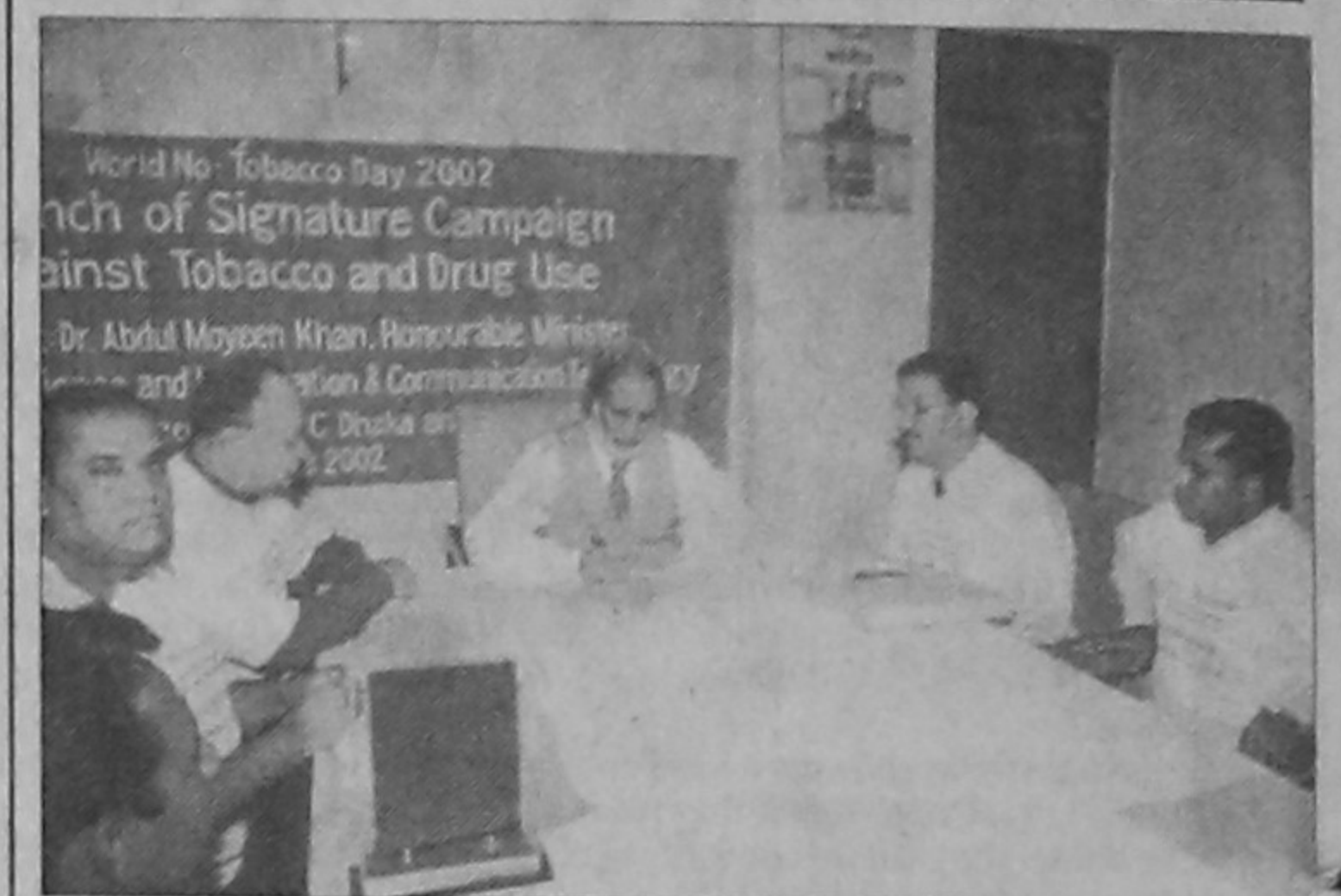
poses, comply to it after approval.

Redwan, however, said the Bangladesh army men on duty in UN peacekeeping missions can communicate with their family members over telephone and e-mail services as well as through postal communications at the cost of United Nations.

They get two months' salary and allowances in advance from Bangladesh before joining their

duty in the UN peacekeeping missions. Besides, 20 per cent of their foreign allowance, while on duty in peace missions, comes to Bangladesh in US dollar through remittance every month, he said.

The state minister said the rest 80 per cent of their foreign allowance are being paid off in the country after the government receive it (subject to the deposition with Bangladesh Bank).
