

President asks Lions Clubs to help contain violence

'Revive cooperative movement'

LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan yesterday stressed the revival of cooperative movement in the interest of the national economy and poverty alleviation.
"Cooperative societies and cooperative activists had played a pioneering role in country's economic growth and we want revival of cooperative movement with effective plan," he said at the inaugural session of a two-day annual convention of cooperative officers.

Presided over by Secretary of the Cooperative Division Dhiraj Kumar Nath, the function was also addressed by State Minister for LGRD and Cooperatives Ziaul Huq Zia, Deputy Minister of the same ministry Advocate Ruhul Quddus Talukder Dulu, Registrar of the Cooperatives M. Ashraf Ali.
The LGRD and Cooperatives minister said the cooperatives

played an important role in attaining success in different fields including agricultural sector in the past, but the common people gradually lost their confidence and interest in the movement with the intervention of a vested groups in the campaign.
He also blamed "insincerity and corruption" of a section of the officials and employees for the erosion of people's interest in cooperative movement.
Bhuiyan said in future stern actions would be taken against the corrupt and inactive officials to regain people's faith in the cooperative movement.
He called upon the officials and employees at the field level to work and assist the people at grassroots level as their friends, well-wishers and near and dear ones.
The government would extend all-out cooperation to make the programme a success as it relates with the poverty alleviation and human development of millions of people.
Cooperative officers from all the upazilas and districts, first of its kind since independence, are taking part in the convention.
At least 3.50 crore people are directly and indirectly involved in 1,37,391 cooperatives societies across the country in different categories.
