

Tk 88.94 crore DU budget placed

The Dhaka University (DU) yesterday proposed a budget of Tk 88.94 crore for fiscal 2002-2003, showing a deficit of Tk 7.84 crore.

DU Treasurer prof. Syed Rashedul Hasan placed the new budget and the revised budget for 2001-2002 at the annual senate session. Vice-Chancellor Prof. Anwarullah Chowdhury presided over the session.

Of the total amount, Tk 73.85 crore will be financed by the government and Tk 7.25 crore from its internal resources.

Of the expenditure budget, 74 per cent or Tk 65.94 crore will be

spent on the salaries and pensions of the teachers and other staff of the university. And Tk 12.65 crore (14.23 per cent) has been allocated for general purposes, including electricity, tax, telephone bill and clinical expenditure.

The expenditure on education support sector has been estimated at Tk 10.36 crore (11.65 per cent).

Before placing the budget, the treasurer urged the University Grant Commission to allocate necessary fund to meet the budget deficit.

In his speech, Prof. Anwarullah Chowdhury assured that the authorities will take necessary measures to ensure educational facilities for the students.

DU VC panel elected

Dhaka University (DU) Senate yesterday unanimously elected a three-member panel from which the Chancellor would appoint one vice-chancellor as per university ordinance, a DU press release said.

The elected panel members are incumbent Vice-Chancellor and Professor of the Department of Anthropology Dr Anwarullah Chowdhury, Dean of the Faculty of Social Science Dr Mohammad Asaduzzaman and Dean of the Faculty of Science Dr A F M Eusuf.

The election was held at the annual meeting of the senate held yesterday with Vice-Chancellor Prof Dr Anwarullah Chowdhury in the chair.

Professor of the Department of Soil, Water and Environment Dr S M A Foyez proposed these three names which was seconded by the former Vice-Chancellor Prof. Mohammed Moniruzzaman Mia. The house unanimously approved the proposed panel.

DESA snaps 71 power connections

Dhaka Electric Supply Authority (DESA) yesterday snapped power connections of 43 defaulter subscribers and 28 illegal users.

Besides, DESA filed cases against 71 persons for illegally consuming power for a long time, a DESA press release said.

Three vigilance teams of DESA snapped the connections during a drive in its Sattamsjid and Lalbagh divisions. The drive began in March last.

BTV earns Tk 45.5 cr from advertisements

Bangladesh Television earned Tk 45.5 crore from advertisements till May 31 of the current fiscal year.

The income has surpassed the current year's target of Tk 42 crore, Information Minister Tariqul Islam said while replying to a question in the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday.

He also said 90 per cent of the entertainment programmes on BTV are produced locally while the rest 10 per cent are foreign programmes.

The government has to give royalties for broadcasting foreign entertainment programmes on BTV.

The year-wise royalty given by the government for such programmes were Tk 98.34,518 in 1996-98, Tk 96,55,752 in 1997-99, Tk 89,23,656 in 1998-2000, Tk 54,85,985 in 1999-2001, Tk 18,00,315 in 2000-2002 and Tk 71,21,322 in 2001-2002.

Tariqul Islam also said Bangladesh Betar has 8,378 enlisted artists and 1,060 lyricists while Bangladesh Television has 5,947 enlisted artists and 400 lyricists.

Replying to another question, the minister said 12 daily newspapers, five weeklies and two monthly newspapers enlisted with the DIP are being published from Chittagong.

2 cops accused of taking bribe

Two police officials have been accused of taking bribe from a poor family at Nandipara in the town on the pretext they are engaged in illegal activities.

The victims - Jatindra Saha and his son, Ratan Saha, at a press conference here on Thursday alleged that the two officials raided their house and demanded Tk 20,000 to relieve them of the charge.

Finally, they settled for Tk 500 and left the house.

When contacted, Sub Inspector Tanveer denied the allegation of taking bribe and said they had raided Jatindra's house to arrest an accused person.

Jatindra and his son are engaged in making candles.

Govt plans 6,000 MW power generation by 2007

UNB, Dhaka

The government plans to raise power generation to 6,000 megawatt by 2007 when the demand will rise to 5,368 megawatt, State Minister for Power Iqbal Hasan Mahmud told the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday.

At present, the country generates 3,200 MW electricity but the demand is more than that, he said while replying to a question from ABM Ashrafuddin (BNP).

To meet the power deficit, three power plants are being set up both in public and private sectors, he said, adding that setting up of five more plants are under process.

Replying to another question from Shah Md Ruhul Quddus (Jamaat), the state minister said the present government extended electric lines by 8,801 km.

Necessary plan has also been taken to increase transmission and distribution capacity along

with increased power generation, he said.

The Power Grid Company of Bangladesh has been set up to manage the transmission and the Ashuganj Power Company Ltd has been formed to run the Ashuganj Power Plant, he said, adding that Haripur Power Centre has started functioning as a strategic business unit.

CU proposes Tk 41.65 cr budget

The Chittagong University (CU) authority proposed a budget of Tk 41.65 crore for 2002-2003 fiscal year.

The proposed budget with a deficit of Tk 5 crore was placed at a joint meeting of university syndicate and financial committee at the Vice-Chancellor's Office.

The Chief Comptroller of the university Siddiquir Rahman presented the budget before the members of the syndicate and the financial committee. Vice-Chancellor AJM Nooruddin Chowdhury presided over the meeting.

According to sources, Tk 34 crore of the budget will be financed by the University Grants Commission and Tk 2 crore from the internal resources of the university.

The discussion on the proposed budget will continue till June 30.
