## Janaza of Dr Neelima Ibrahim tomorrow

Namaj-e-janaza of eminent academic and writer Dr. Neelima Ibrahim will be held tomorrow. The first namaj-e-janaza will be held at Mahila Samity premises at 11.00am while the second at Bangla Academy at 12.00 noon and the third at Dhaka University Mosque at 1.00pm.

Dr. Neelima Ibrahim died at the Metropolitan Medical Center in the city on Tuesday evening at the age of 81. She had long been suffering from high blood pressure and diabetes.

She left behind husband, four daughters, grand sons and grand daughters and a host of admirers.

Prime Minister Khaleda Zia yesterday expressed her deep shock at the death of Dr. Neelima

Ibrahim.

In a condolence message, the prime minister expressed her deep sympathy to the members of the bereaved family and prayed for the salvation of the departed soul.

Sammilito Sangskritik Jote (SSJ) also expressed condolence at the death of Dr. Neelima Ibrahim.

In a message, the jote lauded her contribution as a teacher of Dhaka University and director general of Bangla Academy. The nation will remember her for her courageous role during the hours of need, it added.

The janaza of Hossain was held in the university administrative building premises on June 16. Hossain was buried at his family graveyard at Kholabaria village in Rajshahi district the same day.

## President for continuous research on herbal medicine

BSS, Dhaka

President A Q M Badruddoza Chowdhury yesterday underlined the importance of carrying out continuous research on traditional medicine in the country for its improvement.

"It would be difficult to maintain the existence of Unani and Ayurvedic way of treatment in the country if their development were not ensured in the light of modern science and technology" the President said while inaugurating a national seminar on traditional medicine at Osmani Memorial Auditorium.

All restrictions on the movement of goods including medicine will go after 2005 in the light of agreement under WTO making local Unani and Ayurvedic compete with the imported stuff.

The two-day seminar on "development strategies for traditional medicine: need of the twenty first century" is being organised by Bangladesh Unani Medical Association (BUMA).

The inaugural session chaired by Hakim Hafiz Azizul Islam,

president BUMA, was addressed, among others, by Justice Mohammad Abdur Rouf, Chairman, Seminar Advisory Council, National Professor Dr Nurul Islam, AFM Fakhru Islam Munshi, President, Bangladesh Ayurvedic Parishad and Prof Hakim Abdul Mobin Khan, Vice President, Central Council of Indian Medicine.

President Chowdhury said the practitioners of traditional or herbal medicine must realize that

the old way of thinking will not keep them alive. They must make all-out efforts to improve this branch of medicine and take advantage of the great possibilities that are being opened to traditional system of treatment as witnessed in the western developed countries.

He said these days the importance of the development of traditional medicine are being felt by different quarters and it is a fact that the quality of traditional medicine could play an important role in the health care sector. He said because of its advantages such as curative capability, free from side effect and competitive price, the traditional medicine has already become popular in the developed countries like USA and European Union and gaining ground every day.

There will be a total of 11 scientific sessions where nearly 70 papers will be presented. Nearly 400 Hakims from all over the country have assembled for this year's seminar, the first occasion when the seminar is being held for two days, the organisers said.

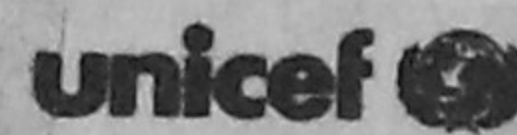
