

Bangladeshi peacekeepers earn Tk 1749.29 cr: Khaleda

BSS, Dhaka Members of the Armed Forces have so far earned Tk 1749.29 crore by taking part in the United Nations peacekeeping forces in different countries, Prime Minister Khaleda Zia told the Jatiya Sangsad yesterday.

success in UN peacekeeping missions," she said while replying to a question by BNP lawmaker Alhaj Mohammad Sobraddudin of (Kushia) during the Prime Minister's question hour. Khaleda said the Bangladeshi troops were working as members of multinational forces to uphold peace and tranquillity in different

countries under the UN charter. Besides, she said, soldiers and members of the security forces from Bangladesh are also extending their services in de-mining, relief operations and security of the interim governments under the UN peacekeeping missions. She said Bangladesh until now took part in 26 UN peace-keeping

missions in 25 countries. Its officers worked as military observers, military liaison officers, staff officers and contingent members. A total of 24,726 members of Bangladesh Armed Forces took part in these 26 missions out of 43 UN peacekeeping missions, she said.

1410 more arrested, 15 firearms recovered

am yesterday. Police arrested 1,410 people, including 20 identified criminals from across the country during the drive. They arrested 22 persons in

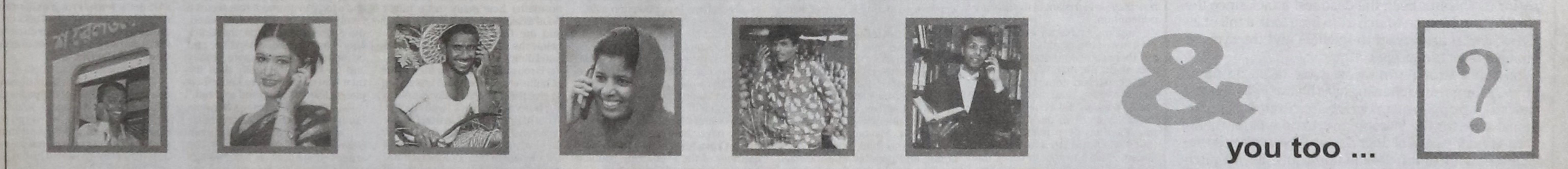
connection with the arms recovery and 10 cases were filed against them under Arms Act, a police headquarter press release said yesterday. Police also recovered eight ex-
