

# Stop misuse of logo

## BDRCS urges people

BSS, Dhaka

Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BDRCS) has asked all concerned to stop the misuse of the organisation's logo which is widely seen across the country.

Sources at BDRCS said as per Geneva Convention, the logo of the insignia of this international humanitarian organisation is supposed to be used at the time of war when its size would be bigger for physical protection of the user.

Bangladesh Red Cross Society was established in 1973 under a law which got retrospective effect from December 16, 1971. The name of the Red Cross Society was changed to Red Crescent Society and its logo was changed in 1988 through an amendment of the law.

At normal time, the users of this symbol are supposed to be such organisations or individuals who are involved with the activities of international Red Cross or Red Crescent.

They said a good number of people and different organisations and establishments are found to be using the logo without prior permission for its use. This could be either due to ignorance or to

# 1316 more held
