The study presented in the book, 'People's Budget', recommends that there is a need for proposed institutional reforms as the existing institutional set-up has failed to contribute towards poverty alleviation.

It also recommends decentralising the current planning and budgeting system. It calls for making a long-term strategic review of public expenditure and democratise priority setting through intimate dialogues with relevant stakeholders.

The study also calls for enhancing citizen's participation in the budget-making process and organising public hearing.






