

Moderate rain or thundershowers accompanied by temporary gusty wind is likely at most places over the country during the next 24 hours till 6pm today.


Heavy rainfalls may also occur at places over Chittagong, Barisal, Khulna, Dhaka and Rajshahi divisions, Met office sald.
