The meeting approved test relief of 630 metric tons of rice for to Indonesia destitute families of 13 flood affected, waterlogged and river eroded districts and house building grants of Tk one lakh and 800 pieces of saris and 800 pieces of lungis for three affected districts.

This allocation is additional to the already approved Tk 51.17 crore, said a PID handout.

The 13 districts for which the allocation was made were Nilphamari, Sirajganj, Bogra, Feni, Sunamganj, Netrokona, Mymensingh, Pabna, Dinajpur, Rangpur, Jessore, Cox's Bazar and Tangail.
