Munna Murder Case Killers still at large

BSS, Dhaka

More than 18 months have already elapsed after the kidnapping and murder of schoolboy Kamrul Hassan Munna, but police could make little headway in arresting the main culprits.

Relatives of the victim said that if police had taken timely measures, they would have easily rescued Munna and arrested the "identified culprits" who had kidnapped and later murdered the 11-year-old boy.

Munna's uncle Mohammad Shamsul Haque blamed the then Officer-in-Charge Saiful Islam and Sub-Inspector Kaiyum of Keraniganj Thana for the inaction.

He alleged that they did not take any initiative to arrest the "identified kidnapers" who confessed to the abduction at a meeting of local elders. But police did not take them into custody or made any effort to rescue the boy, he said.

The two officers, however, were suspended and demoted for negligence of duty later.

The prime suspects were forced to appear before the local Panchayat and Musalli committees where they confessed that they had kidnapped Munna.

The family also accused the local Union Parishad Chairman of helping the killers escape as the matter was referred to him for justice.

Munna, a student of class five of Dhaniala Government School and College, was kidnapped by a group of miscreants from his village home at Ekruia on January 9 last year.

Keraniganj police recovered his decomposed body from a ditch of the village 14 days after the incident, but none was arrested until the case was shifted to the Criminal Investigation Department (CID).

The CID, however, so far arrested six accused in the case, but the prime suspects are still at large.

Investigating Officer Inspector Chandra Bhusan Majumder of CID told BSS yesterday that the abductors had killed Munna, fearing they would be identified as the victim had known them.

1393 more held, 9 firearms seized

BSS, Dhaka

Police seized nine firearms, four other weapons, 13 bullets and arrested 1,393 people from across the country during the last 24 hours ending at 6 am yesterday.

Of the arrested, 724 are police wanted, 655 accused in different cases under investigation and three identified criminals, a police headquarters press release said.

Ten persons were arrested in connection with the arms recovery and six cases filed under the Arms Act.

Of the 12 firearms, Cox's Bazar police recovered three and other districts police seized the rest.

Meanwhile, Dhaka Metropolitan Police recovered three explosives and filed a case after arresting one person in this connection.

The arrested identified criminals are Mohammad Alim of Khulna city, Hazrat Ali of Tangail and Milon of Rajshahi.
