### One beaten to death in city

Extortionists beat to death an embroidery employee at work at Palashnagar in the city's Pallabi area last night.

Din Mohammad, 22, son of Mohammad Mainuddin, came under attack at 8:00pm, when he did not yield to the extortionists' demand for money. Din Mohammad was at work in the Noor Mohammad Jari House owned by Kuddus Miah.

## Poor woman has more mobility in rural areas: Study

BSS, Dhaka

The mobility of women in the rural areas has less to do with greater empowerment but more to do with the income status, a recent study of CARE Bangladesh

According to the study on livelihood monitoring and poverty profiles, poorer women have more mobility and they visit the local markets much more than the middle class women in the rural

Poor women go outside home to sell labour, collect fuel, fetch water and work as domestic helps. Women involved in nonheld outside the village.

The study also pointed out that Tribal and Hindu women are more mobile than Muslim women. They are involved in outside agriculture labour because there are less social and cultural barriers for them. Women from female-headed households are more likely to be involved in outside activities than women from male-headed households. The study pointed out that 49 per cent go to the market, 43 per cent visit medical facilities and 47 per cent visit local government

In the decision-making category, the study pointed out that but often cannot attend meetings after marriage, most assets become the husband's and cannot persons.
