Lawyer seeks security

A Supreme Court lawyer who was allegedly manhandled by his fellowmen on July 1 seeks security of his life amid threats by the attack-

Advocate Rabindra Ghosh, also a human rights activist, alleged that three lawyers roughed him up tacks. and snatched his video camera while he was filming a Supreme Court Bar Association meeting that ended in pandemonium on authoritative investigation into

He said the attackers also took away a film that contained some reports of human rights violations, including the death of an Awami League worker who drowned in a pond near Dhaka after being chased by police.

Ghosh, the country coordinator of US-based Human Rights Congress for Bangladesh Minorities (HRCBM), said he has filed a general diary with Ramna police station and appealed to the Bar Association for taking steps to have his camera and films back.

"But nothing worked. I have not yet got my things back nor the attackers stopped threatening me." Ghosh said.

Meanwhile, Amnesty International has expressed concern for Ghosh's safety and urged the government of Bangladesh to protect him from further threats and at-

The UK-based organisation appealed to the Prime Minister to ensure a full, impartial and July 1 attack on Rabindra Ghosh and bring the attackers to justice regardless of their party affiliation or political position.

Similar appeals have also been made to the Home Minister, the Deputy Minister for Home Affairs and the Inspector General of Po-

Earlier, the HRCBM condemned the reported attack on Advocate Ghosh and urged the Prime Minister to instruct the lawenforcers to provide immediate protection to him and return his camera and documents.

Smuggled Indian goods flood northern districts

Smuggled Indian goods flooded different parts of the bordering northern districts, including the rural hats and bazars in the bordering belts, posing a severe threat to marketing of local consumers products.

According to business sources and eyewitness account, the goods are being smuggled into Bangladesh even in broad daylight.

The buses, trucks and trains are being used for carrying the smuggled goods round the clock especially in the border points and routes at Panchagarh, Thakurgaon, Dinajpur, Joypurhat, Naogaon and Rajshahi districts.

The smuggled goods included sarees, ready-made garments, electronic goods, crockery, cattle, sugar, salt, onion, fertilizers, phensidyl syrup, drugs and imitation ornaments.

From the bordering points, the smuggled goods are carried by buffalo carts, rickshaw vans, motorcycles or on boat to the adja-
