

Qulkhwani of Moazzem Chy today

Qulkhwani of Moazzem Ahmed Chowdhury will be held at Old (Bannani) DOHS Community Centre in the city after Asr prayers today (Monday, August 5), says a press release.

Moazzem Chowdhury, who passed away on August 2, was born in Sylhet in 1922. He was the eldest son of late Khan Bahadur Abdur Rahim Chowdhury. His mother, Zobeida Khatun Chowdhury, was a prominent social worker and the first Bengali Muslim woman politician.

After completion of his Intermediate from M C College, Sylhet, Moazzem Chowdhury obtained Masters Degree from Calcutta University. He was general secretary of the Calcutta Muslim Students Federation and a close associate of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman. He played a prominent role in the crucial referendum in 1947 in Sylhet. During this time, he came into close contact with Hussain Shaheed Suhrawardy and Sher-e-Bangla A K Fazlul Haque.

Moazzem Chowdhury was a Member of Pakistan National Assembly from 1965 to 1969. He actively participated in the Bangladesh Liberation War.

After the Independence of Bangladesh, he retired from active politics and concentrated on his diversified business interests. In his capacity as the owner of tea estates, he was closely associated with the tea industry in Bangladesh.

A life-long bachelor, Moazzem Chowdhury was an enthusiastic traveller whose travels included an overland car journey from Karachi to London in 1960.

Friends, relatives and well-wishers have been requested to attend the qulkhwani.

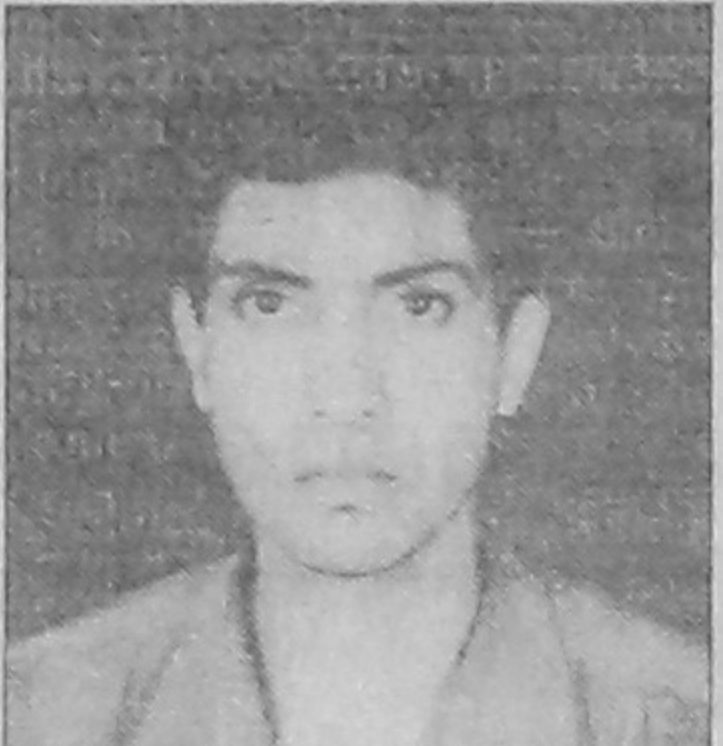
CMCCSU polls today

Dhaka-Ctg train service disrupted for 10 hours

Train service between Dhaka and Chittagong was suspended for about ten hours yesterday as a goods train derailed at the middle point of Fazlpur and Muhuriganj stations near Feni town in the morning.
Railway sources said the train service was suspended at 10.15 am. It was restored at 8 pm.
Six passenger trains were stranded on both sides of the place of accident.
A high powered committee, constituted in this connection by Bangladesh Railway, is investigating the cause of accident.



Appeal for help

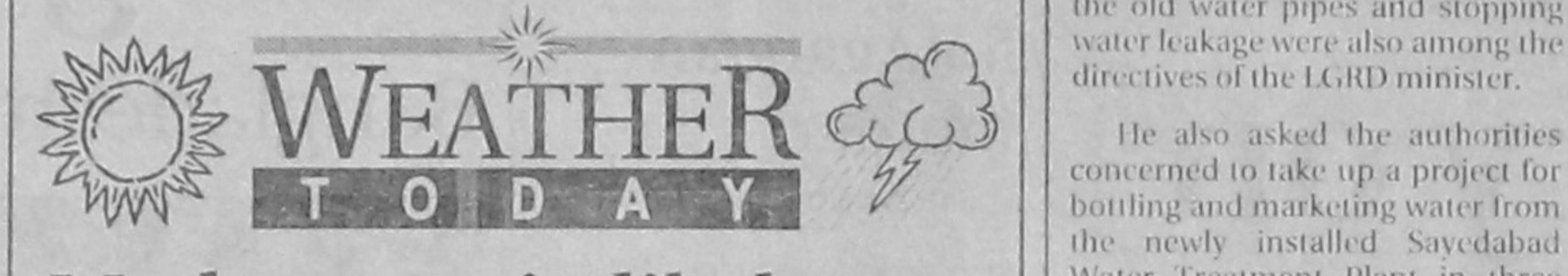

The highest and lowest temperature and humidity recorded in some major cities and towns yesterday were:

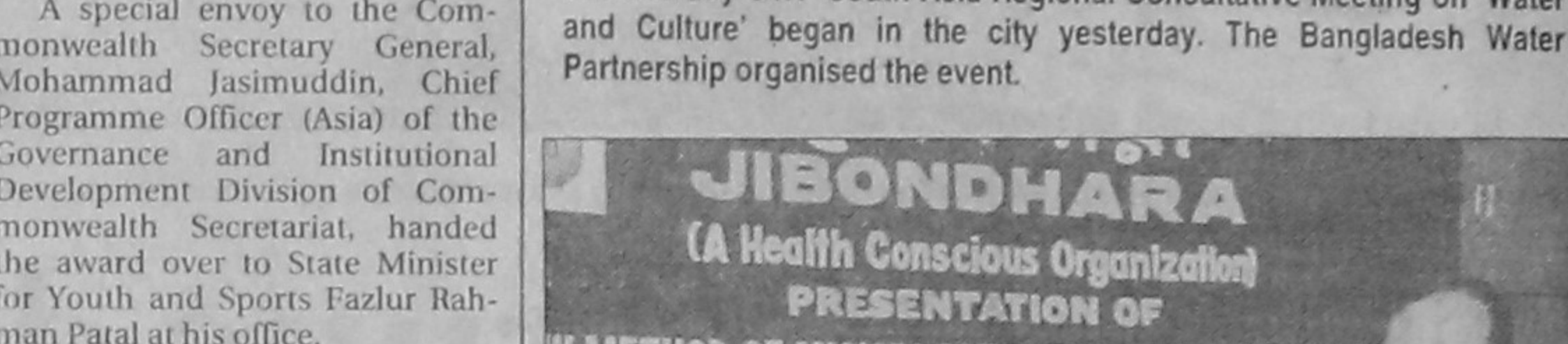

Lawyers protest court fee hike

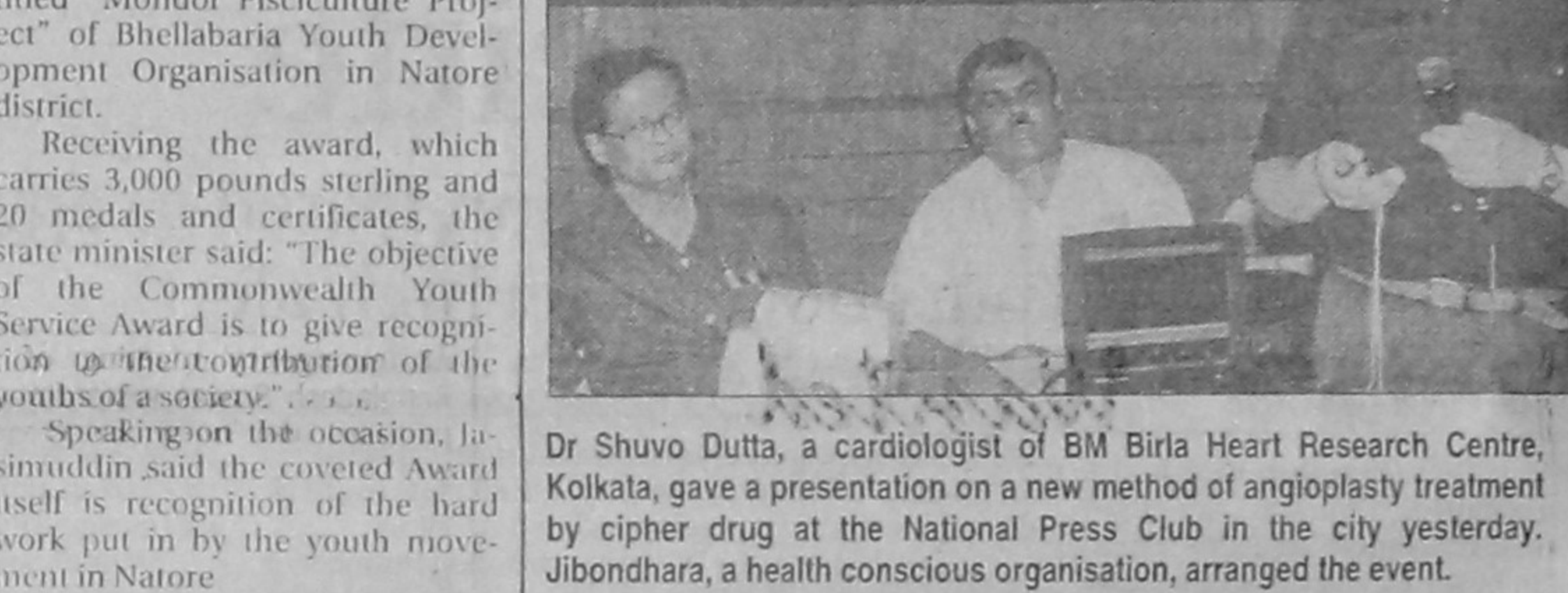

Dhaka receives C'wealth Youth Award 2002

Bangladesh yesterday received the prestigious Commonwealth Youth Award-2002 for its successful work for youth development.
This is for the first time that Bangladesh received this Pan Commonwealth Youth Service Award after being selected from among the forum's 54 member states.
A special envoy to the Commonwealth Secretary General, Mohammad Jasimuddin, Chief Programme Officer (Asia) of the Governance and Institutional Development Division of Commonwealth Secretariat, handed the award over to State Minister for Youth and Sports Fazlur Rahman Patil at his office.
The country was accorded the honour particularly for an outstanding performance of a scheme titled "Mondol Pisciculture Project" of Bhellabaria Youth Development Organisation in Natore district.
Receiving the award, which carries 3,000 pounds sterling and 20 medals and certificates, the state minister said: "The objective of the Commonwealth Youth Service Award is to give recognition to the contribution of the youths of a society."
