

Qulkhwani of Moazzem Chy today

Qulkhwani of Moazzem Ahmed Chowdhury will be held at Old (Banani) DOHS Community Centre in the city after Asr prayers today (Monday, August 5), says a press release.

Moazzem Chowdhury, who passed away on August 2, was born in Sylhet in 1922. He was the eldest son of late Khan Bahadur Abdur Rahim Chowdhury. His mother, Zobeida Khatun Chowdhury, was a prominent social worker and the first Bengali Muslim woman politician.

After completion of his Intermediate from M C College, Sylhet, Moazzem Chowdhury obtained Masters Degree from Calcutta University. He was general secretary of the Calcutta Muslim Students Federation and a close associate of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman. He played a prominent role in the crucial referendum in 1947 in Sylhet. During this time, he came into close contact with Hussain Shaheed Suhrawardy and Sher-e-Bangla A K Fazlul Ha-

Moazzem Chowdhury was a Member of Pakistan National Assembly from 1965 to 1969. He actively participated in the Bangladesh Liberation War.

After the Independence of Bangladesh, he retired from active politics and concentrated on his diversified business interests. In his capacity as the owner of tea estates, he was closely associated with the tea industry in Bangladesh.

A life-long bachelor, Moazzem Chowdhury was an enthusiastic traveller whose travels included an overland car journey from Karachi to London in 1960.




