### 1353 more held

Police seized six firearms, three other weapons and 200 bullets from across the country during the last 24 hours ending at 6 am yesterday.

and adjacent areas to eradicate Aedes mosquito, vector of dengue virus.

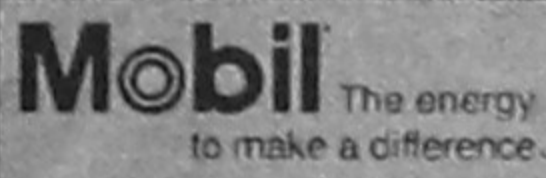
They are going door-to-door and to slum areas and creating awareness by distributing leaflets containing messages about the fatal fever and its prevention, published by Bangladesh Scouts.
