

Transparency in healthcare services a must Speakers tell roundtable

The speakers at a roundtable in the city yesterday underscored the need for establishing transparency in healthcare services.

Accountability, transparency in management and enhancement of skills of the medical professionals, including nurses and technicians, are necessary for providing better services to the health consumers, they said.

The Health Consumers Rights Forum (HCRF) organised the roundtable titled 'Rights of Health Consumers: The Present Situation' to advocate and raise awareness about the rights of health consumers.

In his presentation, Khalid Hassan, a member of the forum, focussed on the nagging problems in the government hospitals and private clinics like negligence, incompetence, absence of staff, overprescription and unnecessary tests.

However, the presentation also dealt with the considerable progress in the health sector since 1973 where the doctor-population ratio has increased from 1: 10740 to 1:4611. Also the life expectancy has increased from 56 to 61.

People like Selim Akber and Abdur Rahman who lost their dear ones or suffered due to the negligence of medical team, shared their agonies with others.

The problems which are confronted by the doctors were also discussed by the speakers.

"The doctors do not work on their own but have the management or authority above them," said Dr Mosaddeque Hossen Biswas, president of the Bangladesh Private Medical Practitioners Association. "A proper integration is needed to provide better service to people."

Politicisation and trade unionism should be restricted to make the medical team work in peace, said Dr Zakir Hossain of Urban Primary Health Care Project, Dhaka City Corporation.

The speakers also placed some suggestions for the development of health sector. They called for proper registration of quacks, inclusion of course on behavioural science for the doctors and formation of a committee to monitor performance of the medical professionals.

They also underscored the need for availability of generic drugs.

There are 45 major laws directly affecting the health-related issues, said Barrister Akhter Imam. However, enactment of these laws

is necessary to protect the public interest so that a consumer can sue the service provider in case of deprivation, he added.

The discussion was moderated by Monzurul Ahsan Bulbul, chief news editor of the Ekushey Television.

Prof Mozaffar Ahmed, Borhan Ahmed, executive editor of Janakantha, Momtaz Begum, Dr Morol Nazrul Islam, among others, took part in the discussion.

The bodies were sent to Chittagong Medical College Hospital (CMCH) for autopsy.

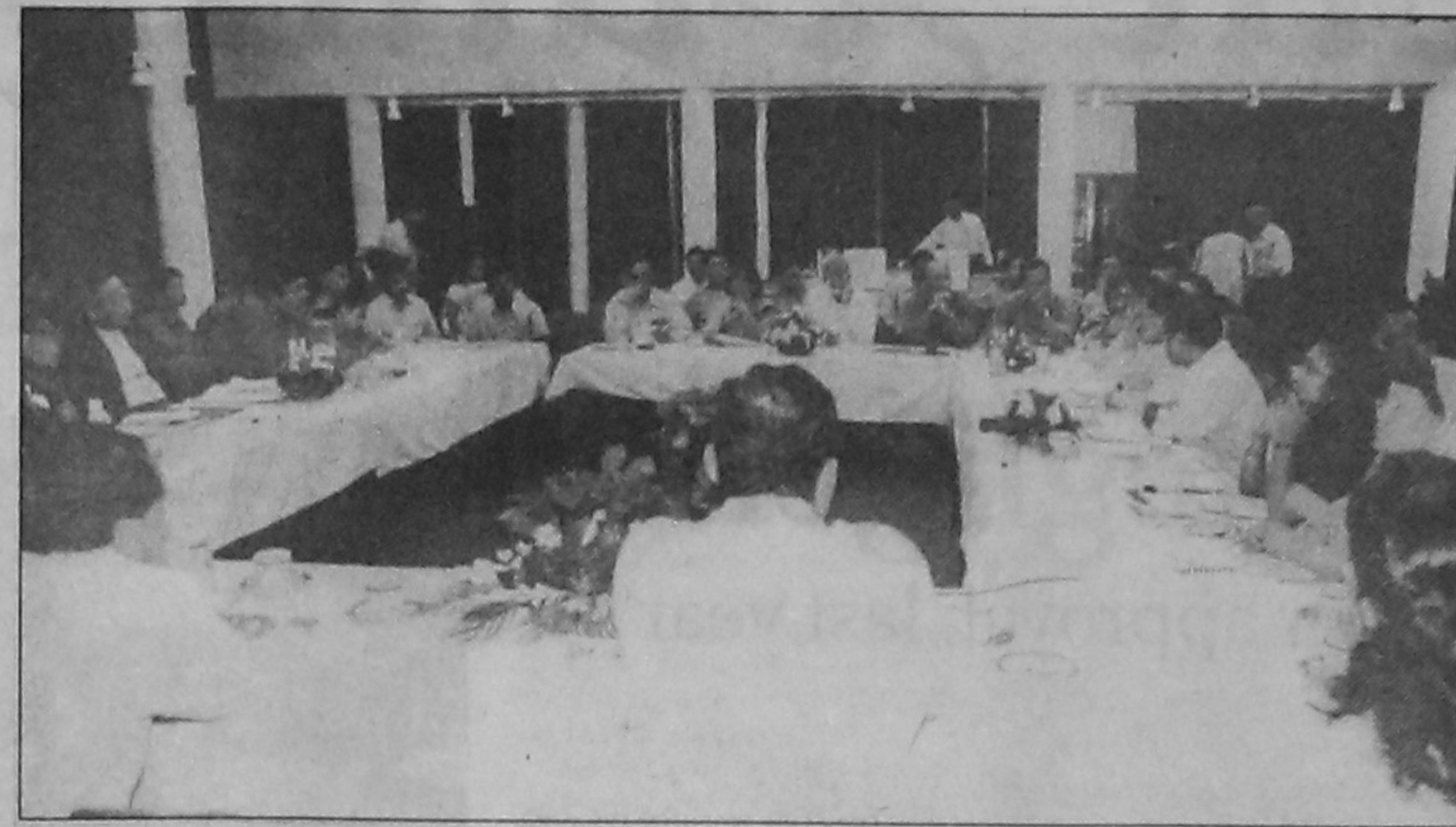
Earlier on Sunday, the two other victims, foreman RN Bose, 45, and Md Shawkat, 28, died at the same clinic.

Printing of primary level textbooks Scrutiny of tenders to be completed this week

The National Curriculum and Textbook Board (NCTB) is making a primary scrutiny of tenders for printing 5.52 crore quality primary level books for the next academic year.

NCTB sources told BSS yesterday that the verification process will be completed by this week and the Tender Committee will meet later to examine the quoted rates.

As the primary scrutiny of the tenders is yet to be completed, it is not possible to say now who has quoted how much price for printing the books, the sources said. However, the trend is showing that most of the bidders quoted below five per cent of the estimated cost set by the board.

Member (Textbook) of NCTB

Prof Kabiruddin Ahmed Mazumder said participation of over 600 bidders, of whom 175 would get the printing work, reflects their competitive mood.

The bidders were offered to quote both below and above five per cent of the estimated cost this year, he said, adding that if the bidders quoting below five per cent of the cost get the work, the government would be able to save about Tk 60 lakh in printing only.

The member of the board said if more than one bidder becomes lowest in any of the 175 packages, the winner would be confirmed on the basis of a transparent lottery as per conditions of the tender documents.

Mazumder said there is no scope to lower the standard of printing and quality of books, as the board will supply papers and positives for printing the books.

Besides, the quality of printing will be ensured through constant monitoring at different levels, he said.

For the first time, the board will provide high quality positives using modern technology this year, he said.

In reply to a question, Mazumder said the question of influencing or encouraging any bidder to quote a certain rate in the tender does not arise at all.

The bidders know their business well and on behalf of the NCTB, we are vigilant to ensuring the quality and timely distribution of books, he said.

Selected printing houses will get work orders by August 25 and the NCTB is expecting to supply the books to different districts by November 30.

They said the authorities did not take any action against the ICS cadres who roughed up their leaders and abused a female activist.

'Sabina died of brain haemorrhage due to hit on head'

Forensic experts yesterday handed over the autopsy report of the body of housewife Sabina to police saying she suffered brain haemorrhage due to hit on head before her death.

Police said according to the autopsy report the body carried marks of injury on head causing the haemorrhage. But no symptom of rape was found in the report, they said.

Sabina, wife of a bank officer, was murdered at Patenga sea beach area in the city and her floating body was recovered on Thursday.

Police so far arrested her husband and Saifur Rahman Palash, a contractor and neighbour of Sabina's parents, in connection with the killing.

The Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's Court here yesterday extended the police remand of Nazrul for another two days after police interrogated him for the past three days.

Police said they would also seek remand for Palash as his earlier remand ends today.

Investigation officer of the case, Sub-Inspector Serajul Islam said Nehar, 12, a maid of the Sabina's father in law's house was also picked up yesterday for interrogation.

Situation tense over land dispute in Sitakundu

Tension brewed in Sitakundu as a group of miscreants backed by ruling BNP men tried to grab over 6.5 acre of land at Jangle Latifpur on Monday.

The attempt to grab land was, however, foiled as the local people strongly resisted.

Sources said the miscreants, reportedly backed by the relatives of a local minister, made an attempt to occupy the land owned by industrialist Shah Murad who had lodged a general diary (GD) with Sitakunda police station in this connection.

In his GD, Murad alleged that a group of over 60 miscreants equipped with lethal weapons went to take possession of his land on Monday morning. But in the face of local people the miscreants retreated.

Murad also alleged that the ruling party-backed hoodlums might launch another attack at any time.

He said one Fazle Azim Dulal attempted to grab the land with false documents for selling it out to others on plot-basis.

Dulal, however, could not be contacted for his comments.
