Land for CNG stations Body to formulate leasing policy

UNB, Dhaka

As two ministries stood at loggerheads over who should have the authority to permit CNG stations, any such station. an inter-ministerial meeting yesterday decided to resolve all hassles within 10 days.

It also decided not to lease any government land to any person or private business establishment for mendation of the RPGCL and the energy ministry.

The trouble in laying the foundations for the emerging sector started when the communications

ministry came up with invitation Mineral Resources Minister AKM for setting up CNG stations on its land while energy ministry considers it as its prerogative to allow Official sources said the energy

ministry also got seriously annoyed as the communications tries ministry remained silent for four months over permitting 58 CNG stations on lands of railway and roads and highways.

Similar silence was also noticed from the Civil Aviation and Tourism Ministry as well as Agriculture Ministry over issuance of permission for leasing their lands to five other CNG stations. Following the long silence and


