

November 26 to play two Tests and three one-day internationals against Bangladesh.

The hosts' first ever series against the Caribbeans will start with three one-day internationals, the first two matches are at the Bangabandhu National Stadium on November 29 and 30.

The third one-dayer will be played at MA Aziz Stadium in Chittagong on December 3. The port city will also host the first Test, starting on December 8.

The tourists will return to the capital for the second Test, beginning on December 16.

The West Indies 26-day tour of Bangladesh will be the third home series of the Test newcomers after Zimbabwe's visit last year and Pakistan series in January. Yet to make their mark since been




