

"We need a general secretary as soon as possible because it is required for the administration of the federation," said Sultan, who was appointed as the head of BFF last October.

Sultan, who returned on Friday after attending the AFC congress in Kuala Lumpur from August 12 to 14, blamed his lack of home work for pulling out of the AFC election at the last moment.

"Though we filed our nomination much earlier, but I found no one was aware of that even after reaching Malaysia. It was really embarrassing for us when it became obvious that Bangladesh were going to lose. That is why we withdrew our nomi-

nation." reasoned Sultan. "Since it was an election held by names I was a candidate. I could sense that the whole AFC had an impression that I could also be removed any time as it happened with Harunur Rashid last year," he

"I think it was a good decision because we need to give more attention to our domestic affairs than the AFC's." added Sultan.
