

Death anniversary of Salam Talukder today

The third death anniversary of former minister and BNP secretary general Abdus Salam Talukder will be observed today.

Talukder, who played a vital role in the movement against the autocratic regime as well as fought for democracy, died of a cardiac arrest on this day in 1999. The former minister served as the secretary general of BNP from 1988 to June 24, 1996. He also played a pioneering role in forming the four-party alliance and in launching movement against the 'misrule' of Awami League.

Salam Talukder was elected to the second, fifth and sixth parliament from Sharishabari under' Jamalpur district. He was a state minister for law during the tenure of President Justice Abdus Sattar and served as LGRD and cooperatives minister under the government of Prime Minister Khaleda Zia in 1991.

In observance of his death anniversary, BNP and different organisations have drawn up elaborate programmes, including Qurankhwani, milad mahfil and discussions.

The Abdus Salam Talukder Smrity Sangsad held a discussion meeting at the Jatiya Press Club auditorium vesterday. BNP secretary general and LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan attended the meeting as chief guest.

Only 10pc of total grant spent for edn at public universities

Education minister tells roundtable discussion

Education Minister Dr Osman Farruk yesterday said only 10 per cent of the total grant to the public universities spent for actual education purposes to the students.

"It's very painful that 90 per cent of the grant to public universities are being spent for the salaries, wages and other administrative costs, and only 10 per cent for the students' actual academic purposes," he said at a roundtable discussion on "Human Resource Development" at a city hotel.

Organised by State University of Bangladesh (SUB), the discussion was addressed by State Minister for Energy and Mineral Re-Vice Chancellor of the university dent Dr AM Shameem, vice president Dr Mahbubur Rahman Liton.



Dr Farruk urged the authorities of private universities to improve the standard of education to cope with the present job market at home and abroad.

He stressed the need for production of skilled manpower, who would be worthy for themselves and the nation. "The growth of private universities is definite, but qualitative education with new and modern subjects and discipline is a must", Dr Farruk said.

He criticised the management problems prevailing in the private universities. Most of the 30 private universities are suffering from internal conflicts among the founders, trustees, governing bodies and vice chancellors.

He warned that these sorts of conflicts would never bring benefit to the private universities and education in the long run.

The SUB would start its first semester on September 1 in BBA, MBA, Computer Science and Information Technology at the present premises at Dhanmondi.

The university will start a new department, health science, early next year.

Termination of nurse leader Taposhi illegal

The High Court yesterday declared nurse leader Taposhi Bhattachariya's termination as illegal.

A division bench comprising Justice Mohammad Hamidul Haque and Justice Salma Masud Chowdhury delivered the judgement upon hearing a writ petition.

Taposhi Bhattachariya, a senior staff nurse of Shaheed Suhrawardy Hospital and president of Diploma Nurses Association, was suspended on October 10, 2001 on allegation that she was launching a movement against the caretaker government by mobilising public opinion.

She was terminated from her job on February 26, 2002. She filed a writ petition challenging the termination order and upon moving of the petition a division bench of the High Court issued rule and stayed the termination

After hearing the petition, the High Court yesterday declared the termination order illegal.

Senior Advocate Dr Kamal Hossain appeared before the court on behalf of the petitioner while Senior Advocate ABM Nurul Islam and Assistant Attorney General Zaman Akter stood for the state.


