## Project to map solar, wind energy resources

UNB, Dhaka

A pioneering project to map the solar and wind energy resources of 13 developing countries, including Bangladesh, using Satellite Technology and Ground Base Data has recently been launched by the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP).

In Bangladesh, the Renewable Energy Research Centre of Dhaka University has taken up a 30month sub-project (May 2002-October 2004) with the support of the Ministry of Environment and Forests.

Experts are convinced that the project, called the Solar and Wind Energy Resource Assessment (SWERA), may prove that the potential for deploying solar panels and wind turbines in these developing countries is far greater than is currently supposed.
