Monwar Hossain, a student of class three, harbours a dream of flying to Australia someday as he holds an apple sent by the children from Australia as a mark of friendship for him and fellow students in the school.

"I will go to Australia when I grow up and get a good job with my education. I will take mangoes for my friends there as a token of friendship," says Monwar of Rajarampur Government Primary School (RGPS).

This is one of the schools under the government's Intensive District Approach to Education for All (IDEAL) project, aided by Australia. The United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF) oversees the project. Initiated in 1998, the project covers 2000 schools with about 400,000 children in 13 districts.

The project helped raise the student enrolment that was little above 50 per cent five years ago to 97 per cent today. Teachers and officials say the success has been achieved due to the change in the environment of the entire school and motivational campaign for enrolment of drop-out students.

Monwar is one of the fortunate children who got the opportunity to re-enrol themselves. "He is doing very good in his classes. But we had to visit his mother several times to persuade her to send her son again to the school," says Swapna Saha, a

teacher serving the school for 17 years.

Australian High Commissioner to Bangladesh Robert Flynn visited the school last week as a goodwill envoy of Australian children with the fruits and posters they sent for their friends in Bangladesh.

The high commissioner was accompanied by UNICEF local representative Morten Giersing. He observed the teaching-learning process and interacted with the students in the classrooms.

The envoy observed that the IDEAL has remarkably addressed the quality issue in the primary education in the last five years.

The UNICEF representative hoped that the ideas of the IDEAL

Police recovered 10 firearms, one another type of firearm and 33 rounds of bullet from across the country during last 24 hours ending at 6 am yesterday.

They arrested 14 per sons in connection with the arms recovery and filed five cases under arms act, a police press release said.

Besides, police arrested 1628 persons, including 768 warrantees, 837 accused in different cases under investigation and four identified criminals during the period.

programme could be replicated in the Second Primary Education Development Project (PEDP) since the approach proved to be very successful in improving the school atmosphere.

"The local community now feels that the school belongs to them as it runs under a participatory process involving teachers, mothers and pupils besides the School Management Committee," says Nur-E-Alam, Assistant District Primary Education Officer.

Swapna Saha said the pupils learn their lessons through body movement, dance, role-playing, stories, rhymes, songs, model-making and drawing while teachers use a diverse range of attractive learning materials in addition to the traditional blackboards and textbooks.

With the introduction of IDEAL programme, the sitting arrangements in classrooms have also been changed. Mats on the floor have replaced the traditional rows of tables and benches, and pupils sit in semi-circle or form smaller groups to work.

The lower section of the whitewashed walls are painted black to provide a personal blackboard for each child.

Nur-E-Alam said the IDEAL has replaced monotonous teaching style with more creative approaches, making the teaching and learning process interactive and participatory in RGPS.

Sanjoy's death anniversary today

The 4th death anniversary of Sanjoy Talapatra, a 2nd year student of Fine Arts Department of the Chittagong University (CU) and an activist of the Bangladesh Chhatra Union (BCU) will be observed here today.

Sanjoy succumbed to his injury at the Chittagong Medical College Hospital (CMCH) on August 22, 1998. The cadres of Islami Chhatra Shibir (ICS) injured him seriously in an attack at the Batali Rail Station in the city on his way to the campus on August 20.

The BCU CU unit has chalked out elaborate programmes to mark the occasion.

According to the programmes, the BCU will take out a mourning procession on the campus wearing black badges at 10am. Later, they will hold a discussion meeting at CUCSU building at 11am.

The Fine Arts Department of the CU will also take out a procession on the campus in the morning.

Father killed for suing daughter's rapist

A village 'chowkidar' (police) has been murdered and the body left hanging in a tree, a day after he filed a case accusing a young man of violating his 15-year-old daughter.

The incident at village West Sukanpuri in Sadar Upazila of the district on the night of August 15 made the villagers feel helpless at the doubtful role of the police as tension prevails in the area.

The villagers told the UNB that Radhura's daughter was raped about a year ago. Later, the matter was settled in a village arbitration. It was decided that the accused, Dilip Chandra Barman, son of Shashi Mohan, will marry the girl and as a sign of agreement, the two exchanged garlands in accordance with their religious tradition.

But Shashi Mohan, a teacher of Lathoti Government Primary School and an influential person in the village, refused to accept the girl as the wife of his son. In many ways, he harassed Radhura, eventually forcing him to leave his ancestral home and live in the adjoining village, they said.

On the advice of the village arbitrators, Radhura finally filed a case on August 13 accusing Dilip of violating his daughter. But he was killed the following night and his body was found hanging in a tree near his house.

Police found marks of injuries in different parts of the body. The body was handed over to his family after an autopsy.

But Dilip and his associates did not allow cremation of Radhura's body at East Sukanpuri crematorium. His son carried the body to Sarodubi and the last ritual was performed there.

Meanwhile, Shashi Mohan ar-

ranged the marriage of his son with Parul, sister of union parishad member Jamini Kumar Roy, a rich man of village Ruhia-Madhupur, on the same night.

Earlier in the morning, all the 'chowkidars' of Sukanpuri union demonstrated in front of Thakurgaon thana and demanded punishment to the killers of Radhura Barman.

Police recorded the rape case, but they are yet to go for spot investigation.

When contacted, Police Super Amir Uddin told UNB that Additional Police Super Harun-Rashid has been asked to conduct a proper investigation into the rape case and take appropriate action.

Deputy Commissioner Jalal Ahmed said he was aware of the matter and would soon visit the village.
