

its inhabitants." Visa applicants affected by these procedures are informed of the need for additional screening at the time of application and should expect substantial delays of six to eight weeks or more before a visa can be issued, the American Centre said yesterday quoting the

announcement. "We trust that affected applicants will understand that this waiting period is necessary as we strive to make every effort to ensure the safety and security of the United States for all who are here, including foreign visitors."

It said, "We realise that these necessary security measures may affect the travel plans of visa applicants, especially individuals intending to enrol in or continue college and university studies in

The State Department further said, "We recognise that individual applicants may experience inconvenience and hardship if their application takes longer to process than they expected."

But it pointed out that the special security screening procedures affect a limited number of prospective travellers and said the US government is doing everything possible to meet the legitimate needs of prospective travellers.

Since September 11, 2001, the State Department has been engaged with other US government agencies in an extensive review of visa issuing practices for security of the US borders and the nation.

"We will make every attempt to meet the legitimate needs of pro-

spective travellers to the United States, consistent with the priority of our security and legal responsibilities," the State Department

It said, "Our goal is to have assured security within a system that is responsive to everyone wishing to visit the United States.".

However, delays in processing of visas will continue to occur as the Department of State, working with other agencies, brings new information systems on line.
