



Abul Mansur Ahmad's 104th anniversary of birth today

The 104th birth anniversary of late Abul Mansur Ahmad, a noted litterateur, journalist, lawyer and politician of the subcontinent, will be observed today, says a press

The late leader was the senior vice president of East Pakistan Awami Muslim League when it was founded in the late forties.

He was the author of the 21point (Ekush Dafa) election
manifesto of the United Front in
the election of 1954, which
brought the United Front (Jukta
Front) to power, in which, he
served as a minister under Sher-eBangla A K Fazlul Huq. Ekush Dafa
formed the historical legacy of the
6-point programmes of 1966 and
11-point programme of 1969
which later became the one-point
programme for liberation in 1971.

The concept of secularism was propagated and popularised through his powerful writings. Abul Mansur Ahmad, in a five-hour speech in May 1957 in Pakistan Parliament, described Pakistan as a country with two distinct peoples with different languages, cultures and traditions.

In the late fifties, he served as the central commerce and industry minister and acting prime minister of Govt. of Pakistan under the prime ministership of Hussain Shaheed Suhrawardy.

The late leader was awarded the highest civil award 'Swadhinata Purashkar' posthumously in 1979.

Amongst various other awards, he accepted only the Sher-e-Bangla Gold Medal and Bangla Academy Award. Abul Mansur Ahmad was a very

successful satirist in Bangla literature. His books such as 'Aina', 'Food Conference' and 'Gulliverer Safarnama' are among the most powerful political satires in Bangla language.

His political autobiography

'Amar Dekha Rajnitir Panchash Bachhar' (Fifty years of politics as I saw it) is considered the most authoritative account of the politics of 1920-1970 period. He authored many other renowned books.

To mark the birth anniversary of Abul Mansur Ahmad, the Mymensingh Sahitya Sangsad has organised a special seminar in his home town in Mymensingh.

10000 children die of waterborne diseases in city a year

BSS, Dhaka

State Minister for Environment and Forest Jafrul Islam Chowdhury here yesterday said at least 10,000 children die of waterborne diseases in Dhaka city every year.

"The deaths of such a huge number of children take place as because more than 2.5 million people in Dhaka city are deprived of pure water, and 70 per cent were kept out of sanitation facilities," he said at a seminar on "Water and Sanitation System in Bangladesh."

The United Nations Information Centre and Dhaka Community Hospital jointly organised the seminar coinciding with the twoday World Summit on Sustainable Development (WSSD) Fair-2002. The state minister said two-

thirds of the world population, deprived of pure water, live in Asia and the number is much higher in terms of sanitation facilities.

"And that is why the demand

for giving priority to Asia in water and sanitation issue was raised in the current WSSD in Johannesburg," he said.

World summit negotiators of 180 countries yesterday agreed on outstanding key issues like water, sanitation, governance, climate change, trade and finances as part of Johannesburg Implementation Plan to achieve sustainable devel-

Jafrul said if the canal digging programme could be implemented successfully, the nation would be relieved of such disastrous problems of water.

Later, he inaugurated a two-day fair in the city. Ten non-governmental organisations (NGOs) are taking part in the fair.

Another report adds, the country has one physician for each 16,000 people and only 14 per cent of the population have access to the government health services.
