At about 8:30 am the same day, Kamal went there again and called Jewel out of their house and then went to the Nazrul Islam Road on foot. After a while, her mother heard a sound

At about 10:00 am. I got a message over telephone that lewel's body was at Mohammadpur thana. Immediately, I along with some of our neighbours went the police station and identified the body, she said.
