not disagreed with him, but there was no question that Ferdinand and stand-in skipper Michael Owen did so ahead of Saturday's friendly against Portugal

Ferdinand insisted: "Everyone is entitled to their opinion, but that was definitely a long way down our list of priorities.

The United defender actually ended up with two Brazilian shirts, those of Rivaldo and Roberto Carlos, but he has given them both away to his brother, Anton, as the memories of the game are too

Ferdinand also insisted England
