Police action on BUET students condemned

More political parties, student organisations and socio-cultural bodies on Monday condemned police action on students of BUET and demanded reopening of the university.

Jatiya Party (Ershad) chief H M Ershad and its Presidium member Shaiful Alam Prodhan in a joint statement expressed deep concern at closure of BUET due to "obstinacy" of its authorities. They urged the BUET authorities to resolve the problem immediately and reopen the university, according to a party press release.

Anwar Hossain Monju, who leads the other faction of JP, condemned the police action and urged the BUET authorities and the government to take steps to reopen the university.

Condemning the police action, Workers' Party President Rashed Khan Menon and its General Secretary Bimol Biswas demanded resignation of the BUET VC. Left-leaning 41-Party Alliance demanded release of the students

arrested during the police action.

Pro-Awami League teachers of Dhaka University in a joint statement said the "attack on BUET students is unprecedented" and it unveils the autocratic character of the government. They urged the BUET authorities to meet the students' demands and reopen the university.

Bangladesh Chhatra Federation (BCF) brought out a procession in the city yesterday protesting closure of BUET and Dhaka University.

Denouncing the police action, Bangladesh Mahila Parishad also urged the authorities concerned to meet the students' lawful demands and reopen the university.

Other organisations which condemned the police action and demanded reopening of BUET include Jatiya Samajtantrik Dal, Left Democratic Front, Jatiya Gono Front, Bangladesh Krishak Samik Awami League, Biplobi Chhatra Moitree, Bangladesh Muktiyoddha Sangsad, Bangladesh Juba Union, Progressive Lawyers' Front, Bangladesh Chhatra League (Rana-Khokon), Mahila Muktiyoddha Sangsad, Gonoshanghati Andolon, Sammillito Samajik Andolon, Maolana Abdul Hamid Khan Bhasani Parishad, Gono-Sanskriti Front, Bibortan Sanskritik Kendra and Oikya Procheta.

Condemning the police action, 17 former student leaders in a statement said it reminds the atrocities on students during the autocratic rule of Ershad, and it will bring bad consequence for the four-party alliance government.

Signatories to the statement include Obaidul Kader, Kh M Jahangir, Ruhul Kuddus Badshah, Nur Ahmed Bakul, Shireen Akhter, Mahmudur Rahman Manna, Jahangir Sattar Tinku, Akhtaruzzaman, Nazmul Haq Prodhan and Dipankar Saha Dipu.

Our Rajshahi University Correspondent reported that the Students Against Terrorism and Torture, a newly formed body of apolitical students of the university, organised a meeting on the premises of RU Central Library protesting the police action on BUET students.

The meeting was also addressed by some RU teachers and guardians of students. The speakers urged the BUET authorities to meet the students' demands and reopen the university.

Our Chittagong University Correspondent reported that different student organisations belonging to political parties and two teachers' panels of Chittagong University protested the closure of BUET and condemned the police action on the students.
