Jail Killing Case 15th PW gives deposition

COURT CORRESPONDENT

Prof Mohammad Ali Ashraf, a witness in the Jail Killing Case, yesterday quoted the then chief whip Shah Moazzem Hossain as telling him (witness) that the killing of Bangabandhu matters a little because the parliament is very much there.

Ali Ashraf, the 15th prosecution witness, gave his deposition in the Special Court adjacent to the Dhaka Central Jail.

After recording his deposition, Judge Ahmed Jamil Mostafa adjourned the hearing till September 25. Ali Ashraf will be crossexamined by the defence lawyers for the accused on that day.

In his deposition, Ali Ashraf told the court, he was elected a member of the parliament in 1973 from the constituency (Chandina-Devidwar) in Comilla.

"After the assassination of Bangabandhu on August 15, 1975, I was in Dhaka and came to know that the chief whip Shah Moazzem Hossain, KM Obaidur Rahman and Nurul Islam Manzoor, wanted to talk to MPs in the hostel and I also went there. Shah Moazzem said the killing of Bangabandhu matters a little, and there was nothing to be frightened as the parliament was very much there."

"Moreover, top leaders of Awami League -- Syed Nazrul Islam, Tajuddin Ahmed, Captain M Mansur Ali and AHM Quamruz-


