

# BNP-Jamaat regime keeps Shaheed Minar besieged: Hasina

Awami League president Sheikh Hasina yesterday said the BNP-Jamaat regime has kept the Central Shaheed Minar besieged to prevent the people from expressing their grievances against the misrule and torture of the ruling alliance.

"But the people will not allow the government to keep the Shaheed Minar enclosed," she said asking the government to be attentive in ensuring people's welfare instead of continuing "torture and repression" on them.

She visited Chhrata League vice president Rafiqul Islam Kotwal at Shikder Medical College Hospital at Rayerbazar. Kotwal was released from the jail recently.


