Reigning champions and Premiership leaders Arsenal broke an English league goalscoring record that had stood for over 70 years with a 4-1 win away to Leeds United on Saturday.

Nigeria striker Nwankwo Kanu's first goal of two in the ninth-minute meant Arsenal had scored in 47 consecutive league matches.

That was a new record for all four of England's professional divisions, surpassing the mark set by Chesterfield in the old Third Division North way back in the 1929-30 season.

Kolo Toure's 20th minute header and Thierry Henry's strike two minutes after the break put Arsenal well on top.

Leeds grabbed a consolation six minutes from time when Harry Kewell followed-up after England keeper David Seaman had made a double save from Lee Bowyer.

But barely two minutes later Kanu broke clear to seal Arsenal's victory as Arsene Wenger's doubleholders equalled Manchester United's Premiership record of 29 games unbeaten and stretched their lead over Liverpool to five points. But victory for Gerard Houllier's

men at Manchester City later Saturday would keep the gap at two points. Arsenal, worryingly for the rest of

He took one wicket for 16 runs off 10 tight overs of off-spin to put ketball opener pressure on Ricky Ponting's team early in the innings. He was named man-of-the-match for his economi-

cal bowling. "I'm glad I was able to do that (put pressure on Australia), especially when I'm probably playing the last tournament at home," said Aravinda, who will turn 37 next month.

"This was an important semifinal and I really like challenges. I like to take responsibility on my shoulders. in a big game," said Aravinda, who has scored more than 6,000 runs in 93 Tests with 20 centuries.

His biggest moment came in the 1996 World Cup final against Australia at Lahore in Pakistan when he hammered a century and took three wickets to lead his team to victory.

Aravinda said he had not decided whether he would be playing the World Cup in South Africa next year

"I don't know whether I'll be going to the World Cup. I'll probably have a chat with the selectors after this tournament and then decide," said Aravinda, who has scored 8,758 runs in 286 one-dayers with 11 hundreds.



He had had a dream run at this year's Hong Kong Open, knocking out fourth seed Alex Corretja in the second round and fifth seed Juan Ignacio Chela in the quarter finals.

But the Frenchman was unable to hold his own from the baseline with Ferrero, partly because of a severe blister on his smallest toe on his right foot that needed medical attention in between sets.
