

'10pc of world's population suffer from mental illness'

BSS, Dhaka

At least 10 per cent of the total world's population including Bangladesh have been suffering from mild mental illness while one per cent from serious mental dis-

This was revealed in a survey conducted by UNICEF recently. The survey report said that of

the total population at least three per cent of men and four per cent of women have been suffering from mental depression.

Of the total patients, 11-17 per cent commit suicide due to mental depression mainly caused by unemployment, poverty, and complexities in getting married and abnormal impact of biochemical substances inside their bodies.




