**Graft case against Tareq, Arafat Order on acceptance of 'final report' today**

COURT CORRESPONDENT

The Metropolitan Sessions Judge's Court Dhaka will pass an order on acceptance of the final report in connection with a graft case against Tareq Rahman and Arafat Rahman, son's of Prime Minister Khaleda Zia and four others today.

Judge Ahmed Jamil Mostafa will pass the order after scrutinising the case diary (CD) and relevant documents.

Four other accused are -- Gias Uddin Al Mamun, chairman of Rahman Shippers Ltd, Nasrin Sayeed, director, A H M Shawkat Ali Chowdhury, former director of IFIC Bank Ltd and S M Salauddin,

senior executive vice-president, IFIC Bank Ltd, Head Office, Shilpa Bank Bhaban.

Gulam Shahriar Chowdhury an officer of the Bureau of Anti-Corruption (BAC) and also the Investigation Officer (IO) of the case, submitted the "final report" on September 3.

In the final report, the IO mentioned that the charges brought against them would not be proved as the bank earlier gave time to the clients to pay the interest of the loan by April 2004.

In the case, filed with Motijheel thana, it has been alleged that the accused opened a current account in the IFIC Bank, in the city's Dhanmondi Branch on March 15, 1995 in the name of Rahman Shippers Ltd and filed a petition, seeking loan of Tk 2.08 crore for buying four launches. The branch then, without recommendation, sent the proposal for loan, to the Managing Director, IFIC Bank Ltd, Head Office and the Head Office without following the rules of procedure manual advance, recommended for loan of Tk 2 crore. Of it, the accused embezzled Tk 1,085 crore.

The BAC filed the case on May 13, 2001 against the accused.
