She expressed her confidence that Jimmy Carter would continue to work for the establishment of durable peace among nations of the world.

**9 arms seized**

**BSS, Dhaka**  
 Police recovered nine firearms and eight bullets under its ongoing countryside operation in the last 24 hours till yesterday morning.

A police headquarters press release said 1,214 people were also arrested over the period. Of them, 22 people were held in connection with the arms and ammunition seizure and 399 under warrant orders.

Besides, 793 people, accused in under-investigation cases, were held during the period.

**Pisciculture project at Dhaka Cantt inaugurated**

**BSS, Dhaka**  
 An experimental Pisciculture Project under the "more production in less time" programme, jointly initiated by the Fisheries and Livestock Ministry and Bangladesh Army, was inaugurated yesterday, at Army Military Police unit at Dhaka Cantonment.

Fisheries and Livestock Minister and Dhaka City Mayor Sadeque Hossain Khoka inaugurated the project by releasing fish fries in the Army Military Police unit pond, said an ISPR press release.

Earlier, on his arrival at the project area, Khoka was received by the Chief of Army Staff Lieutenant General Hasan Mashhud Chowdhury.

Tilapia (*Oreochromis niloticus*) will be cultured in one pond and Rajputi (*Barbodes gonionotus*) in the other pond of the project. Bangladesh Army will finance the project and Bangladesh Fisheries Research Institute (BFRI) will provide technical support.

Among others, State Minister for Expatriates' Welfare and Overseas Employment, Major (Retired) Md. Quamrul Islam, DG of Bangladesh Fisheries Research Institute (BFRI) Dr MA Majid, DG of Directorate of Fisheries Nasiruddin Ahmed, and senior civil and military officers were present on the occasion.

**Brick fields to be regulated**

**BSS, Dhaka**  
 The government has decided to bring the brick fields under new regulations to protect the environment, according to official sources here yesterday.

The sources said no brick field will be given clearance by the Department of Environment (DoE) unless it has a chimney of 120 feet high.

The brick fields will also have to burn only high grade coal with less sulphur content.

They will also go for producing concrete blocks to encourage better use of bricks, the sources added.

They said the authorities would not permit burning of woods in the kilns.

The new regulations would be conveyed to the Deputy Commissioners shortly to ensure adherence to the regulations.

The decision follows deterioration in environment of the countryside by certain unscrupulous brick field owners using woods, used tyres and setting up the kilns in the residential areas.

There are about 10,000 brick fields in the country. The sources hope that the new regulations if ensured strictly will cut the pollution level and help produce better quality bricks.

The government is also making arrangements so that better quality coal is available to the brick field users containing low sulphur.

**Austria, Bangladesh good friends: Ambassador**

 The outgoing Ambassador of the Federal Republic of Austria to Bangladesh, Dr Herert Traxl, called on president Iajuddin Ahmed at Bangabhaban yesterday.

The President expressed satisfaction at the existing friendly relations between Bangladesh and Austria and hoped that it would improve both in depth and dimension in the coming years, a Bangabhaban release said.

He said Bangladesh considers Austria as an important member of EU and counts on its continued support and cooperation in pushing forward Bangladesh's interest for obtaining greater economic and trade concessions from the EU.

The president said the government had given priority to the education, particularly girls education, and added, Austria could widen its cooperation in this field together with higher technical and specialised education.

He highlighted the liberal investment policy of the government.

The outgoing ambassador recalled his tenure in Bangladesh saying that Austria and Bangladesh are good friends. He expressed satisfaction at the bilateral relations between the two countries which, he added, have been improving satisfactorily.

The ambassador stressed the economic cooperation to the mutual benefit of the two countries.

**'Prof Nurunnahar Trust Fund' set up at DU**

**BSS, Dhaka**  
 A new trust fund titled 'Prof Nurunnahar Begum Trust Fund' has been established in the Dhaka University yesterday, says a press release.

To set up the trust fund Prof Narayan Chandra Biswas of the Department of Sangskrit and Palli of Dhaka University handed over a cheque for Tk 5 lakh to Vice-Chancellor Prof S M A Faiz at the latter's office yesterday.

The cheque-handing over function was attended among others by elder sister of the deceased Mahmuda Begum, younger brother Mostafizur Rahman, Pro Vice-Chancellor Prof A F M Yusuf Haider, Treasurer Prof Syed Rashidul Hasan, Dean of Arts Faculty Prof Kazi Shaheedullah, Chairman of Bangla Department Prof S M Lutfar Rahman, Chairman of Philosophy Department Prof A Q Fazlul Wahid and Registrar of the University Muhammad Selim.

Of the total 5 lakh taka, 4 lakh will be allocated for scholarship fund for female students and the rest one lakh will go to the fund of Centre for Advance Research in Humanities of the University.

From the income of the scholarship fund, 10 female students (two from each department) of the departments of Bangla, English, History, Philosophy and Sangskrit and Palli will be awarded scholarships every year at the rate of Tk 4000 each. Students who will be promoted to third year getting first and second highest marks will be awarded the scholarship. And from the income of rest one lakh taka 'Prof Nurunnahar Begum Human Study Lecture' will be organised on February 16 every year.

Prof Nurunnahar Begum was killed by an unidentified person on February 16 this year at her Baniani residence in the city.
