

UN study, WHO estimates say

Bangladesh has so far been largely spared from AIDS, but unless necessary steps are taken to educate and protect people from HIV infection, the current situation would not last long, an UNDP official said.

World-wide, more than 90 per cent of those infected with AIDS virus do not know their status and the killer disease has risen to be the second among the top four infectious diseases. Bangladesh is now in a situation where it can maintain the HIV infection rate at its current low level, provided effective steps are taken now, the official said.

Between 20,000 and 30,000 people have HIV positive in Bangladesh, according to a UN Study/WHO estimates, UNDP Assistant Resident Representative Dr Najmus Sahar Sadiq said.


