Private Islamic university in Rajshahi soon

A full-fledged private Islamic university would be established very soon at Naodaparha in Rajshahi.

The university will be set up under the social welfare project of Ahle Hadith Movement Bangladesh (AHMB) as a part of which the Jam-e-mosque of the proposed varsity has been already constructed.
