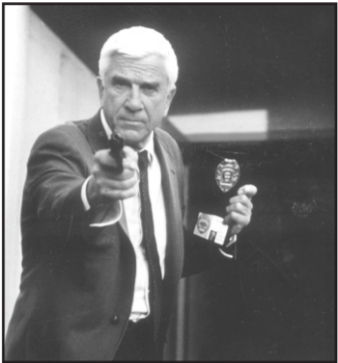
A View through the Window

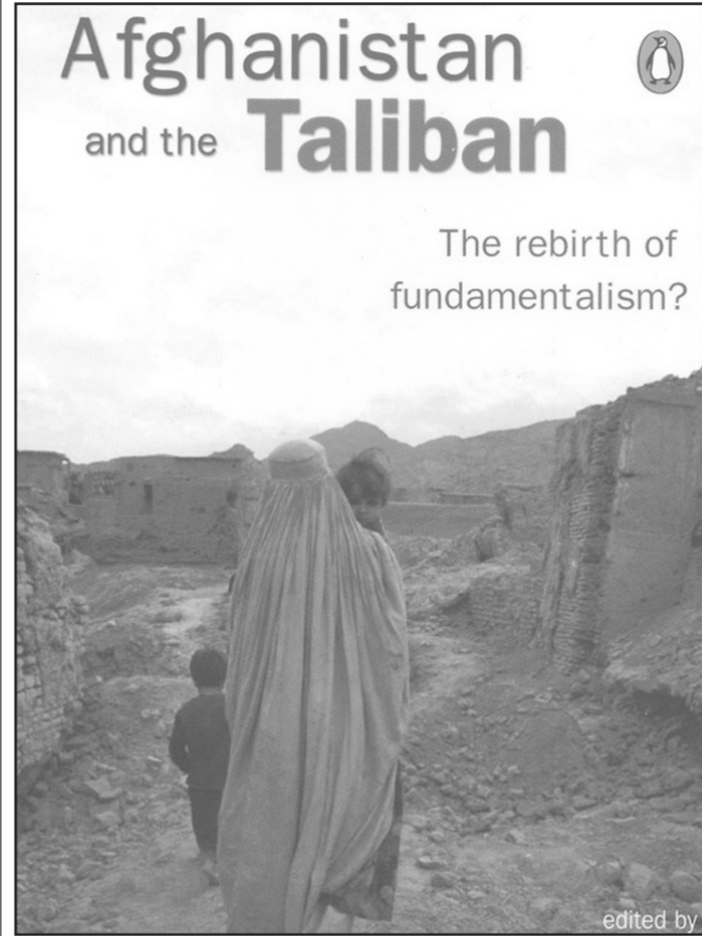


**Rabindranath-er Shilaidah-er Gaan**
