



North South University at a glance

North South University (NSU), the first private university in Bangladesh was established by the NSU Foundation with the initiative of a group of philanthropists, industrialists, bureaucrats and academics. The government of Bangladesh approved the establishment of North South University in 1992. NSU was formally inaugurated on 10 February 1993 by Begum Khaleda Zia, Honorable Prime Minister of Bangladesh. The President of People's Republic of Bangladesh is the Chancellor of NSU.

The University is managed by a number of statutory bodies as required under the provisions of the Private Universities Act 1992. At the apex is the Board of Governors (BOG) of NSU Foundation, the founder of the University, which provides policy guidelines and approves the university budget. The BOG is headed by the Chairman elected by its members. Mr. Iftekharul Alam was NSU attracts foreign students from India, the founder Chairman of the Board of Governors, Mr. M.A. Awal was the second, Mr. M.A. Kashem was the third and Mr. Azim Uddin Ahmed is the immediate past Chairman, Mr. A B M Kamal Uddin Khan is the current Chairman of the Board of Governors of NSU Foundation.

The Porichalona Porshod (Governing Council/Syndicate) is the second highest body after the Board of Governors of the NSU Foundation. It manages the University within the policy guidelines provided by BOG. The Parichalona Porshod consists of BOG members, Vice Chancellor, representatives of the faculty and University admin-

The Vice Chancellor, as the chief executive officer, runs the university with the help of the following statutory bodies: Academic Council, Finance Committee, School of Studies, Curriculum Committee, and Faculty Selection Committee as defined in the Private University Act 1992. The Registrar maintains the university records and keeps liaison with University Grants Commission (UGC), Ministry of Education and other relevant authorities. The university follows an American system,

including semesters, credit hours etc. and parallels the academic calendar in North America. Its curricula have been reviewed by relevant departments of University of Illinois, Urbana-Campaign, and University of California at Berkeley, USA and duly approved by UGC. The academic programs have been revised

and adapted to meet the local needs. Since joining NSU in 1993, Dr. Hafiz G.A. Siddigi, current Pro Vice Chancellor, provided leadership in improving, expanding and diversifying various academic programs. Since April 1998, Dr. Siddigi has been carrying out additional duties and responsibilities of

the Vice Chancellor. The first freshman classes of January 1993 had 137 students enrolled in three Departments: Business Administration, Computer Science and Economics Departments of Environmental Studies (DES), English and General and Continuing Education (GCE) were added later. The Masters Program in Economics was introduced in 1994. The MBA Program was launched in Summer 1997. Degrees awarded are Bachelors and Masters in Business Administration, BS in Computer Science, Computer Engineering & Economics, MS in trators from universities and international Economics and Master in Development Studies, BA in English and BA/BS in Environmental Studies. NSU has two institutes: (i) Institute of Development, Environment and Strategic Studies (IDESS), a research unit of NSU and (ii) the English Institute.

The first convocation was held on 18 December 1996 when Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed, Honorable President, Govt. of Bangladesh and the Chancellor of NSU, conferred degrees upon 96 graduates. In the 4th Convocation held on November 25, 2000, 165 graduates including the first batch of 45 MBA graduates were conferred degrees. The 5th Convocation on November 11, 2001 conferred degrees School of Applied Sciences will be appointupon 203 graduates, including the first batch of English and second batch of 29 formed and Professor Khaliquzzaman M.

MBA degree recipients. Professor Dr. lajuddin Ahmed, Honorable President of Bangladesh and Chancellor of NSU will confer degrees upon 251 graduates at this 6th Convocation on November 2, 2002. NSU so far has produced a total 952 graduates. Most of these graduates are employed in internationally reputed companies. Many are pursuing higher education in renowned universities abroad.

The credits obtained at NSU are acceptable to most of the better known universities of USA, Canada, Australia and other countries. NSU graduates have been accepted in the Graduate programs of Harvard, Cornell, University of Pennsylvania, and other well-known universities. Six Economics graduates of NSU are studying for higher degrees at York University, Canada, with financial aid provided by York University.

The Library is fully automated for providing better service to the faculty and students. This is a first on-line automated library operation system introduced among the university libraries in Bangladesh. It uses computerized database and circulation system for record keeping, reservation. Users can search and reserve books from distant work stations of NSU through LAN. The holdings of the library cover scholarly

and scientific disciplines, particularly business, economics, management, computer science, environmental studies, English language and literature, Bengali language and literature, history and culture, psychology, sociology, etc. The total number of books is over 25,000 and is constantly replenished. It subscribes over 234 journals including 143 on-line journals. In addition the library subscribes 54 Dailies and magazines and has a separate reference and broadband connection.
